

1.3.19. Secondary education drop-out rates, by sex, education authority, province, language of instruction and Year level 2018, 2019, 2020

Secondary education drop - out rates by year level have a decreasing trend from 2018 to 2020 for all year levels and genders except year level 13 for females (see chart - 1.3.19 a).

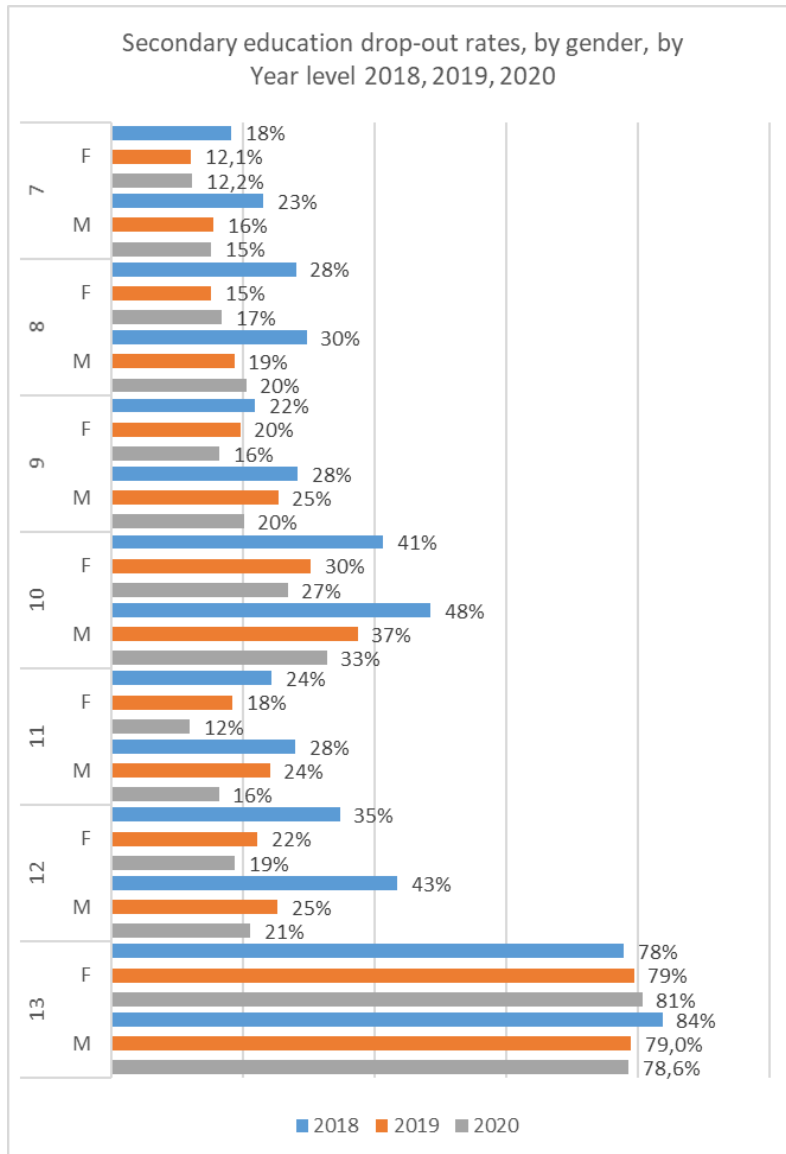

The decreasing trend from 2018 to 2020 observed in the year levels at country level is valid for the two main education authority, Government assisted Churches and Government of Vanuatu for all year levels with few exceptions (YL 13 and YL 14 - Government of Vanuatu for females, YL 14 - Churches, not assisted by government for females) with differing sizes of changes. The trend changes direction within the private schools and those governed by Churches that are not assisted by the government (see chart - 1.3.19 b for the rates of year levels 7 to 10 and chart - 1.3.19 c for year levels 11 to 14).

Secondary education drop-out rates for Year levels between 7 and 10, by gender, by education authority, by Year level, 2018, 2019, 2020

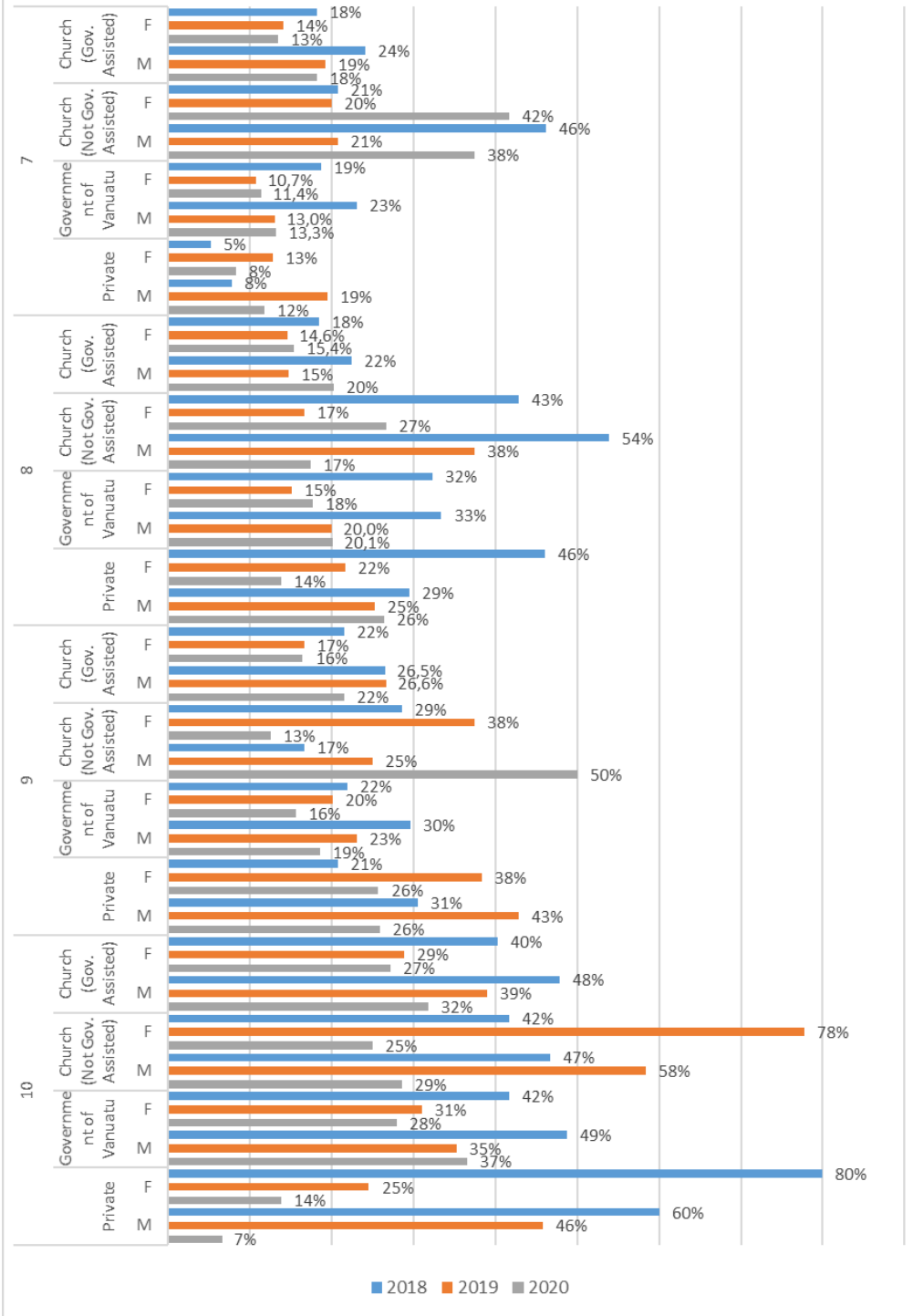

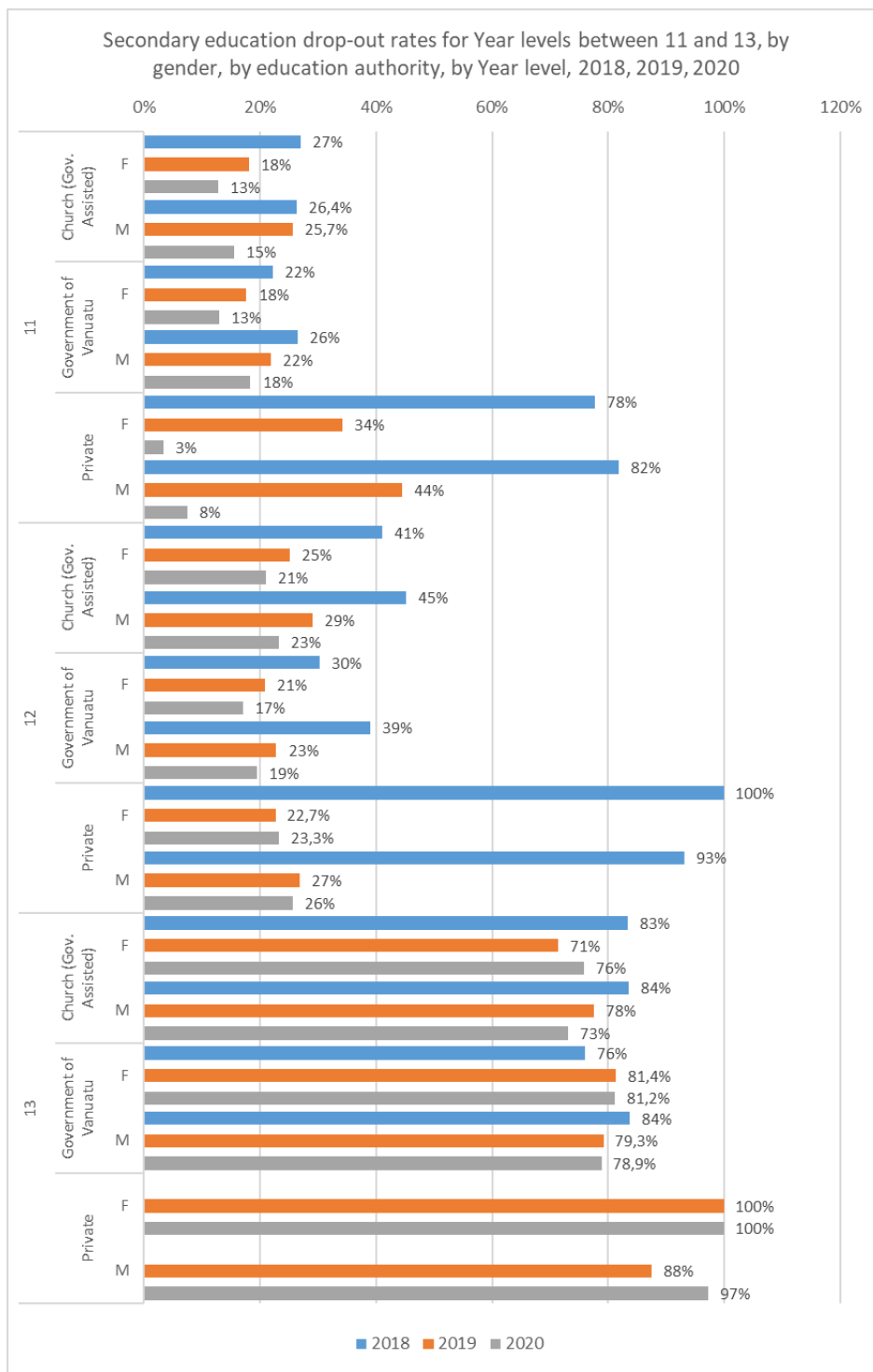

The decreasing trend observed in all year levels and for both genders with education authority as Churches assisted by the government is valid at province level, in Malampa, Penama and Torba provinces. The trend changes direction in Tafea province for year levels; 7,8,9 and 11, in Shefa province for year levels 8,9,13,14 and in Sanma province in year level 13.

The decreasing trend in drop-out rates observed in schools with education authority as Government of Vanuatu at country level for each year levels (except 13 year level) is valid for all provinces and genders in year level 7, 10 and for the rest the trend changes direction for certain provinces (i.e. females and males

for YL 7 in Torba, females for YL 9 in Penama (please see 5 charts chart - BB to chart - ZZ for province level disaggregation of drop out rates within the two main education authorities)

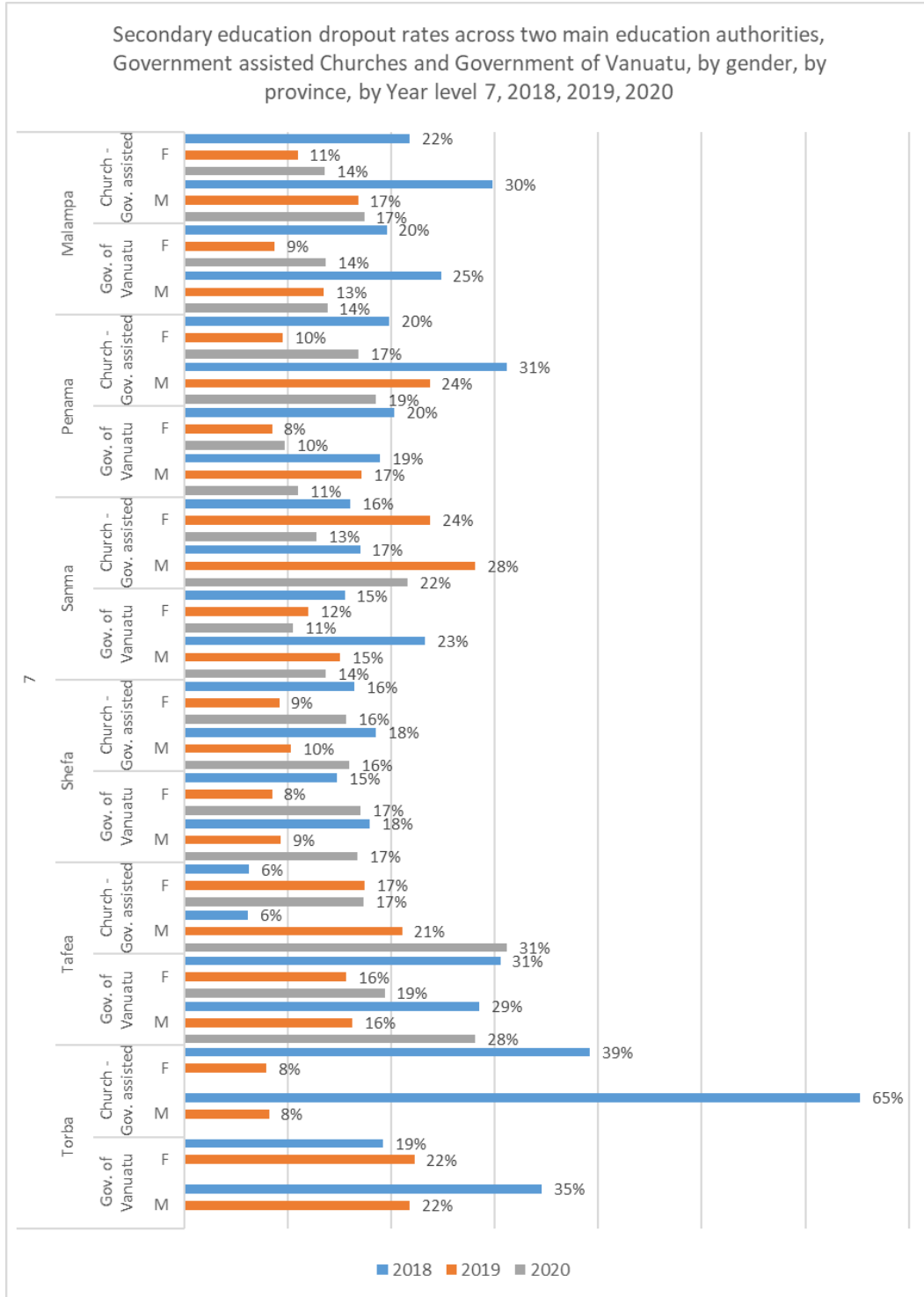

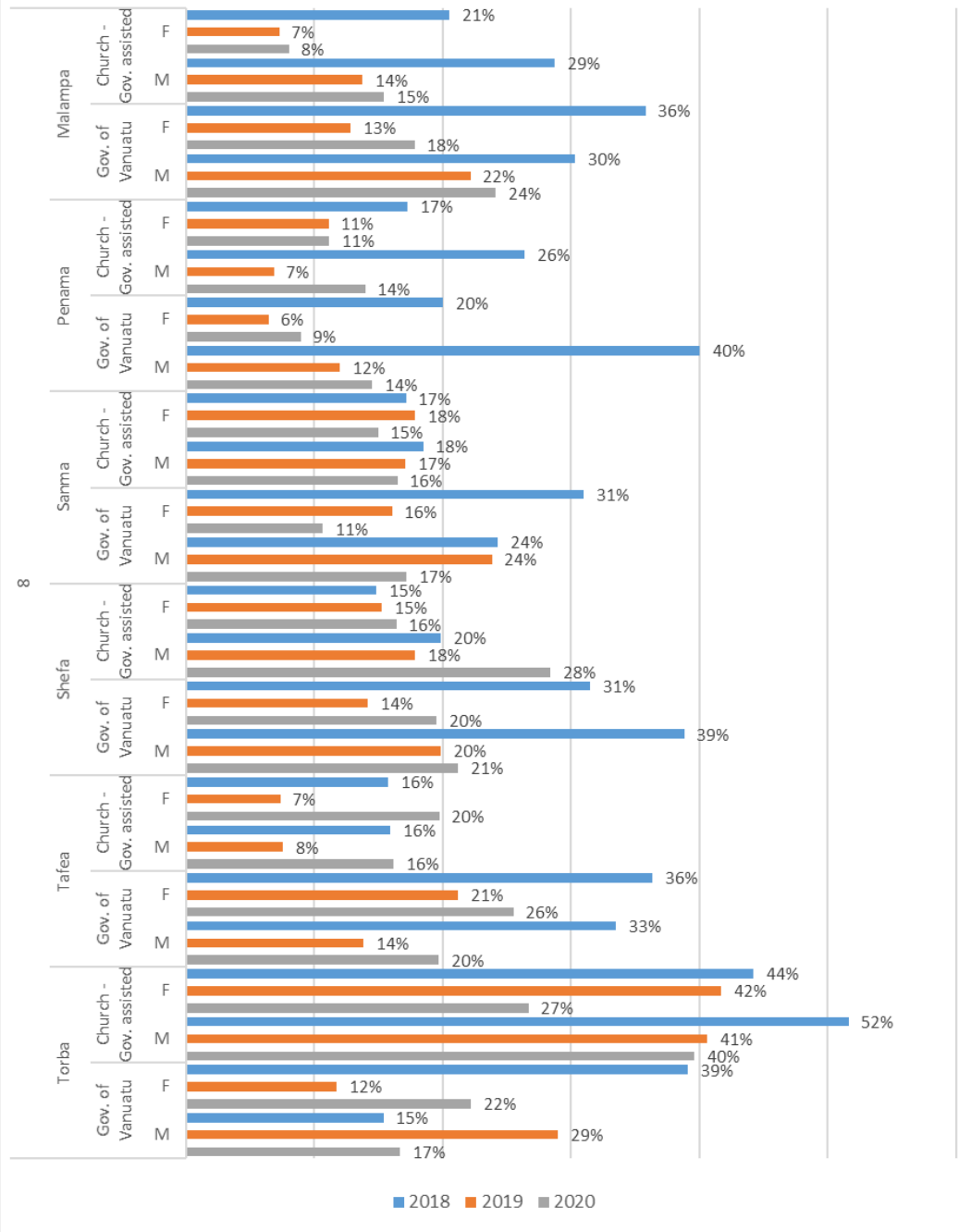

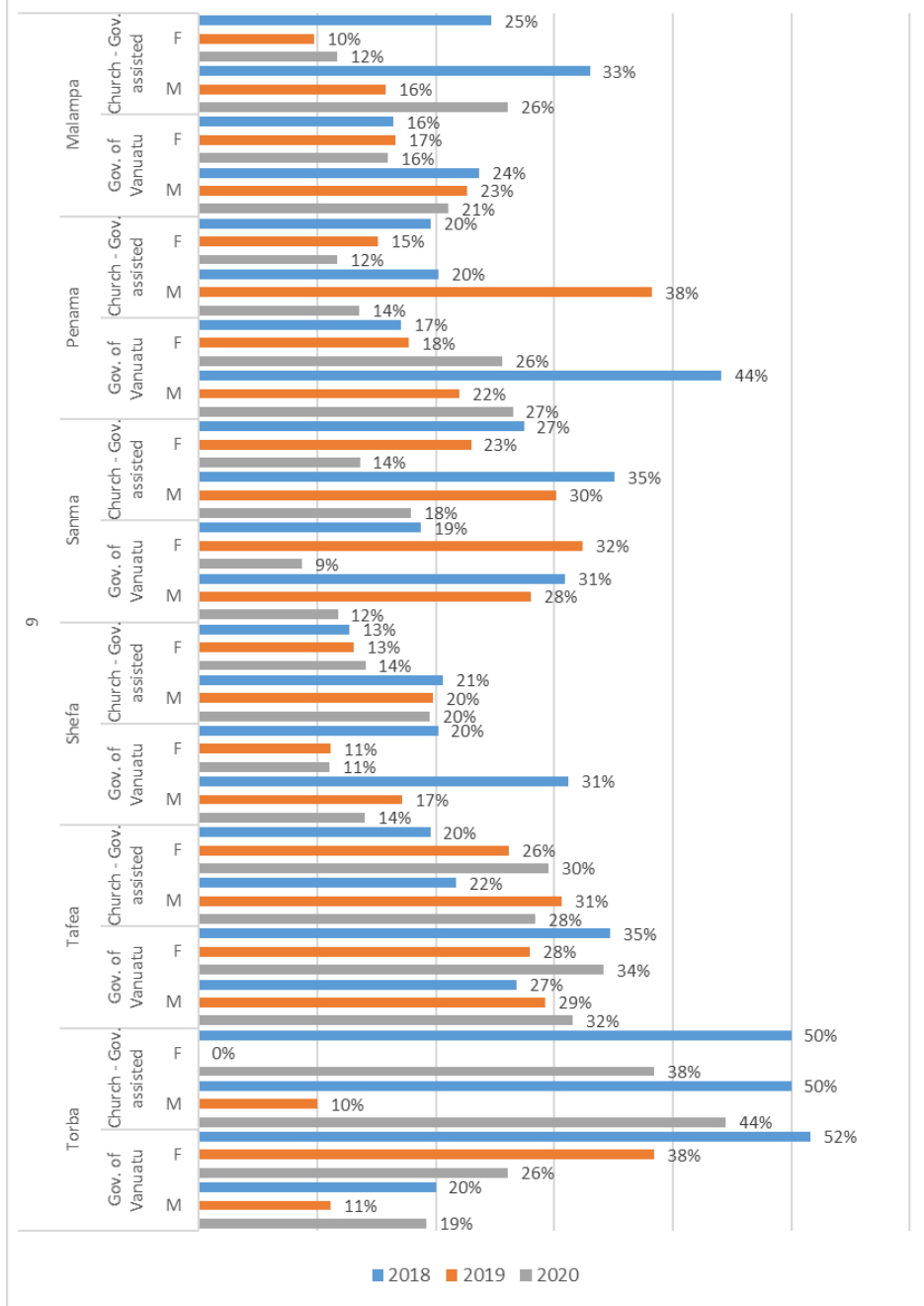

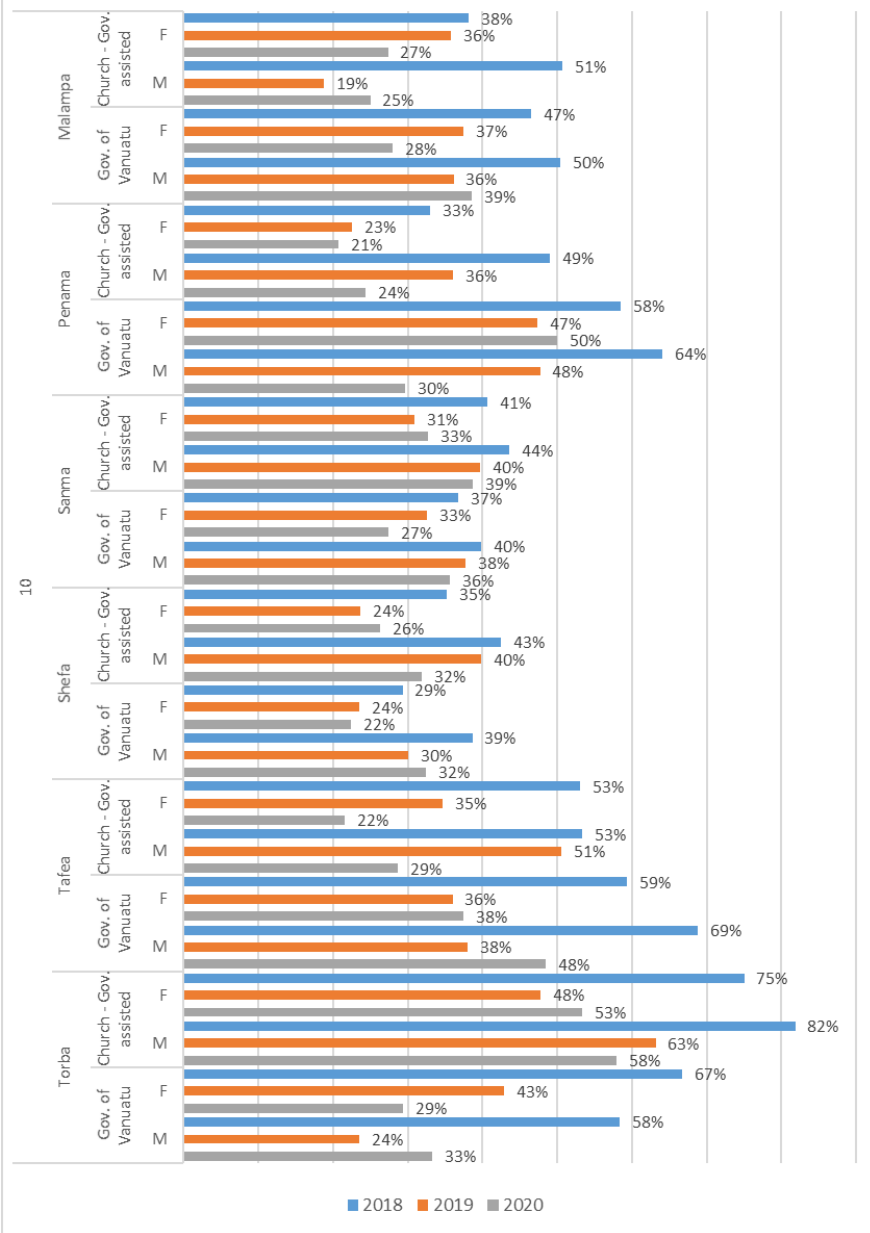

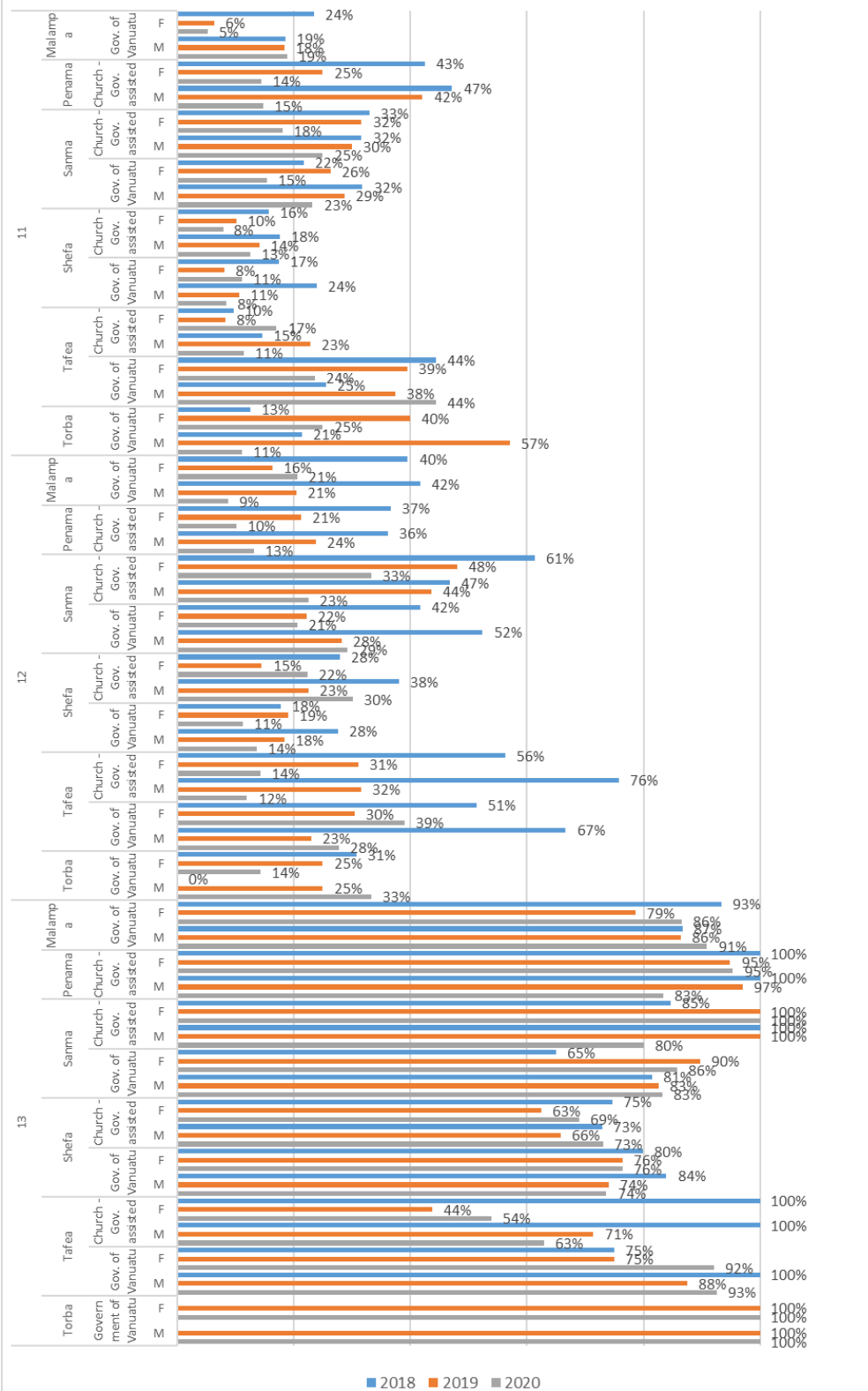

The trends in drop - out rates within private schools and those governed by Churches that are not assisted by the government changes across the year levels, provinces and genders. 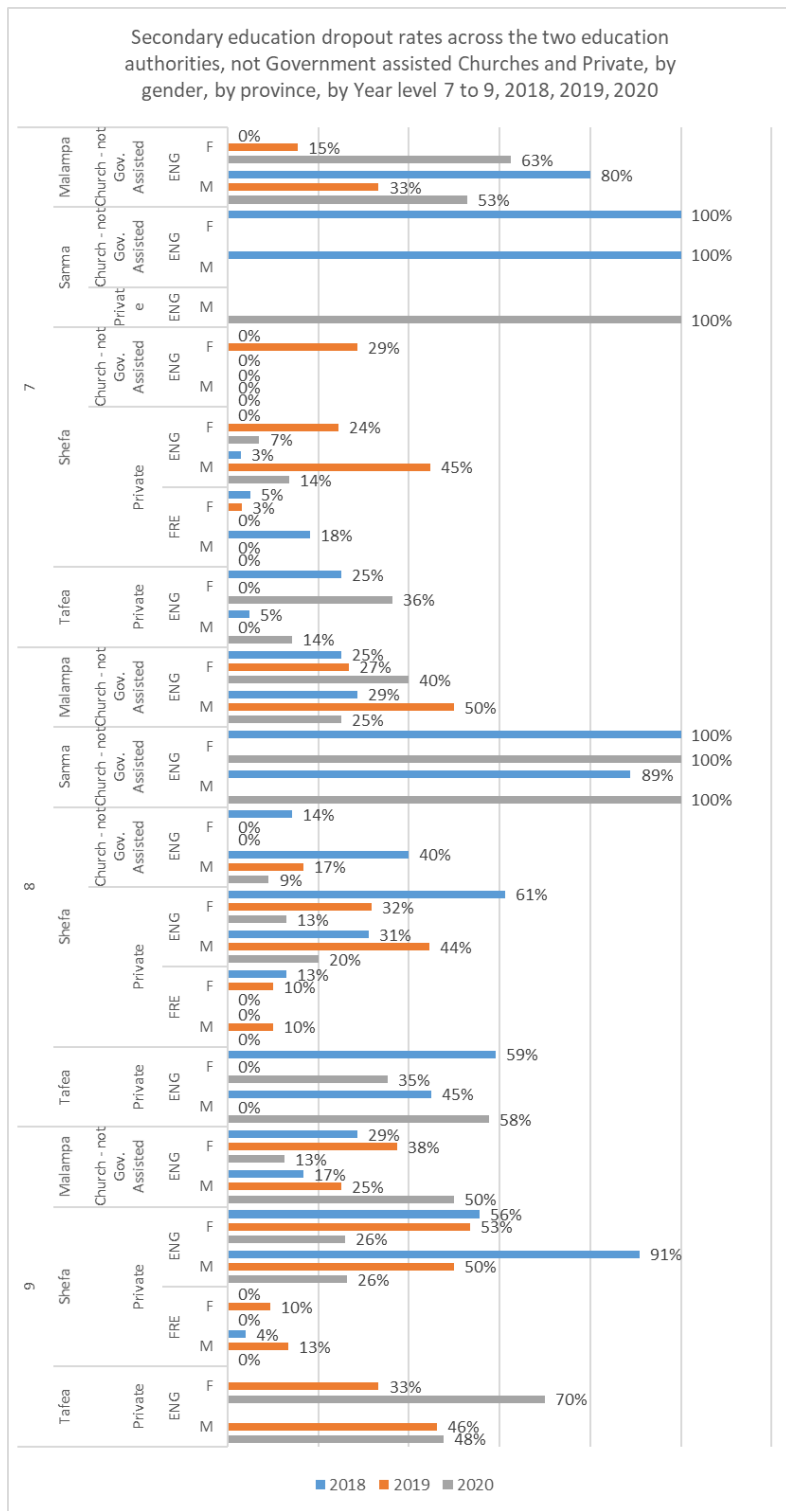

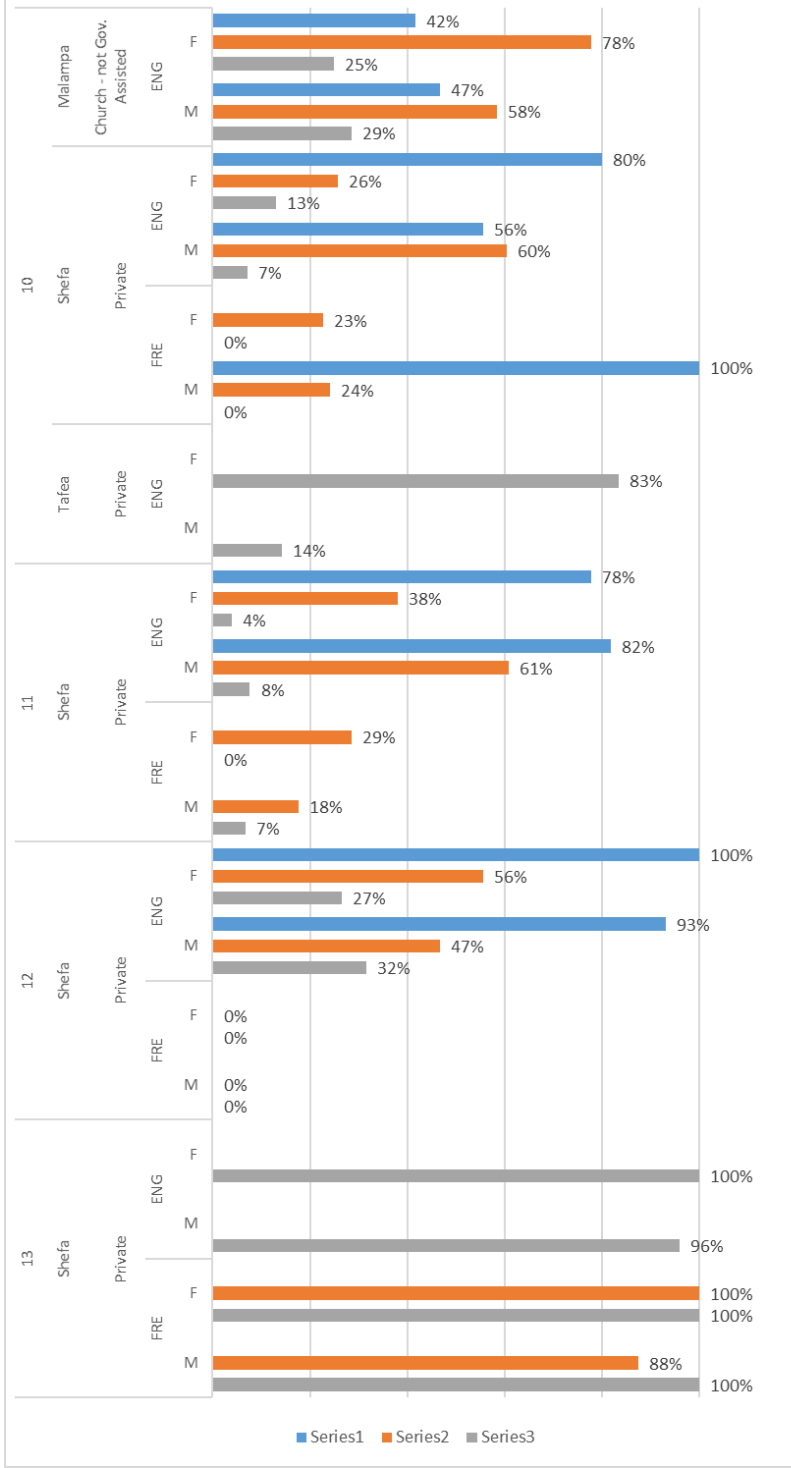

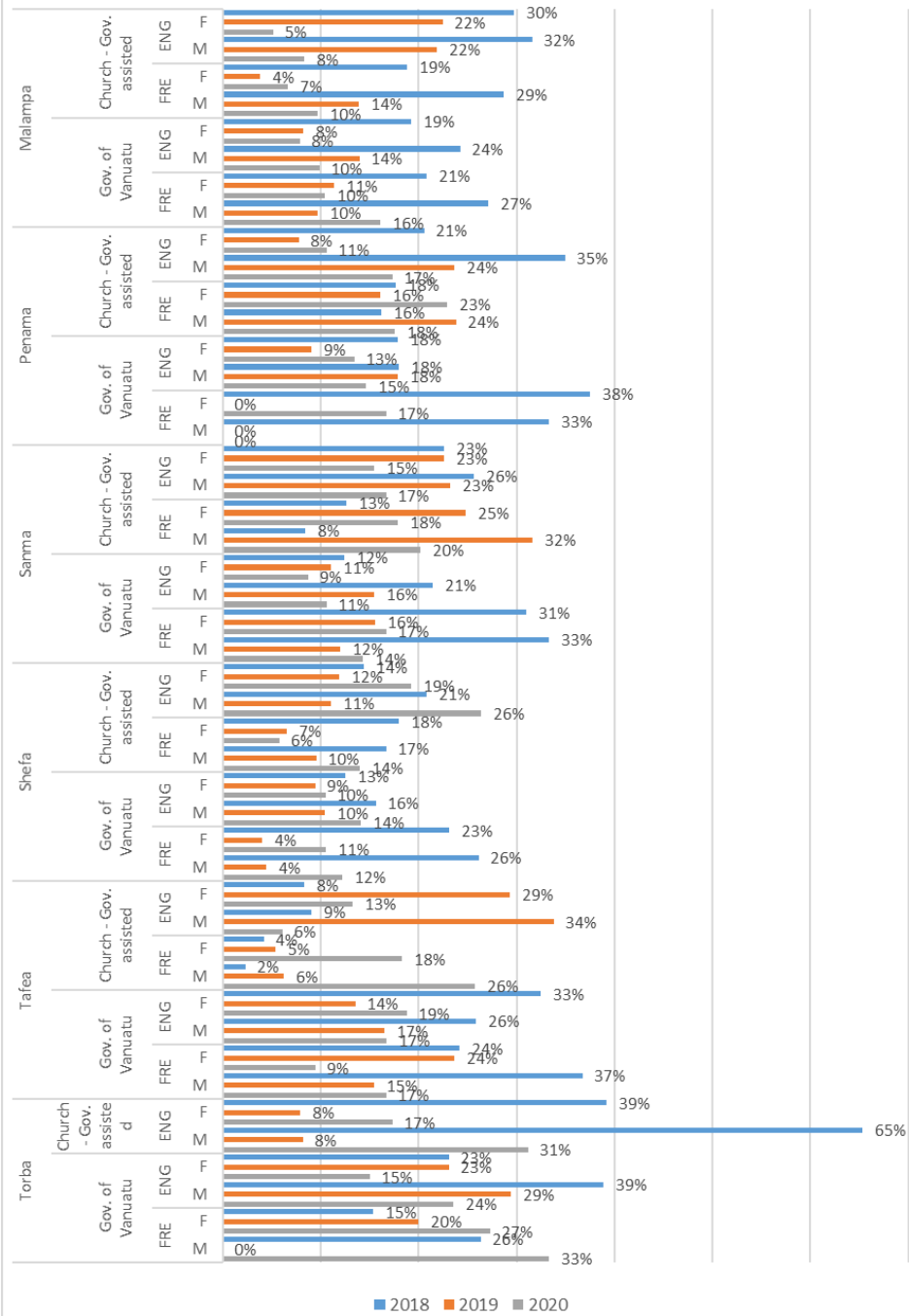

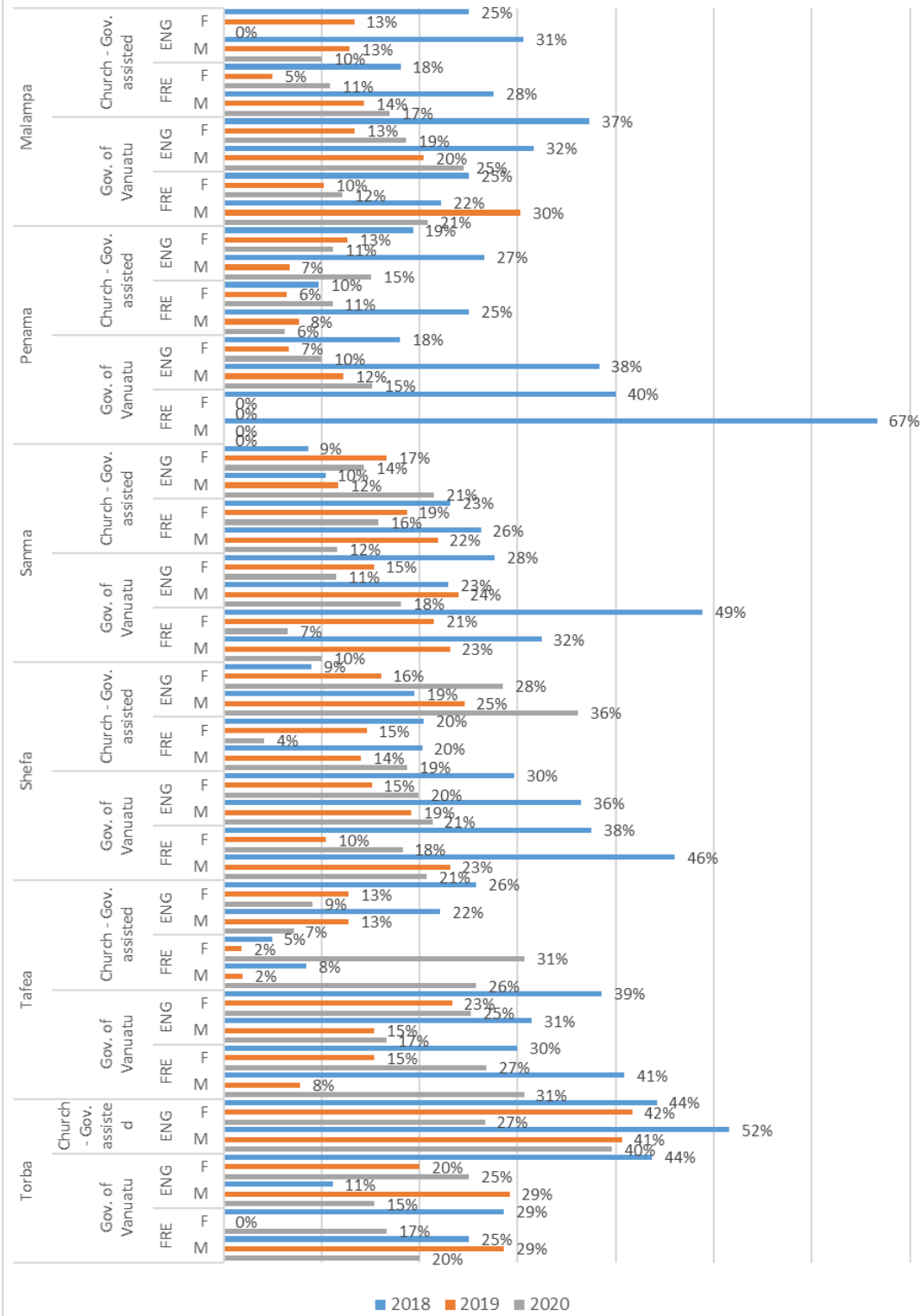

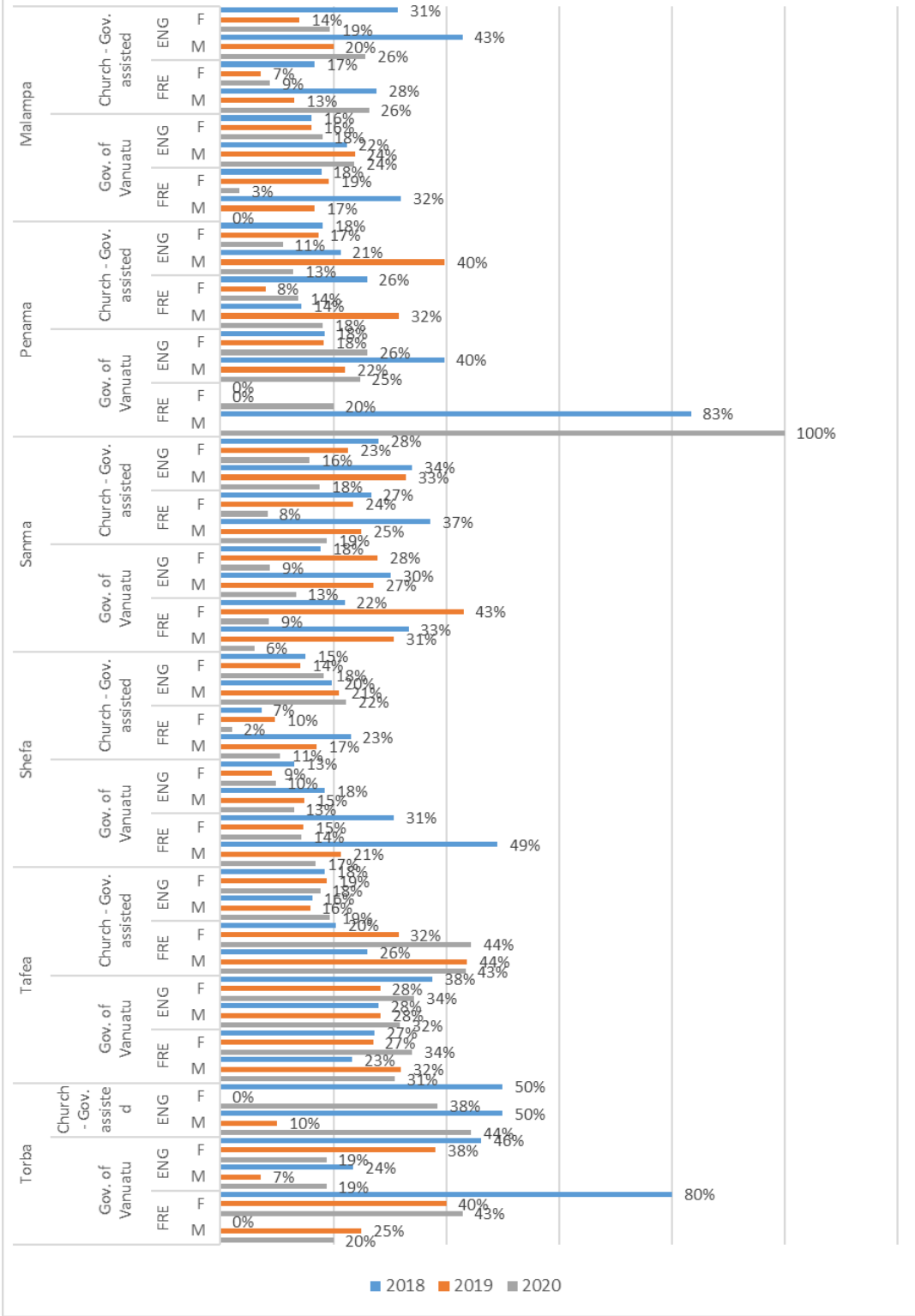

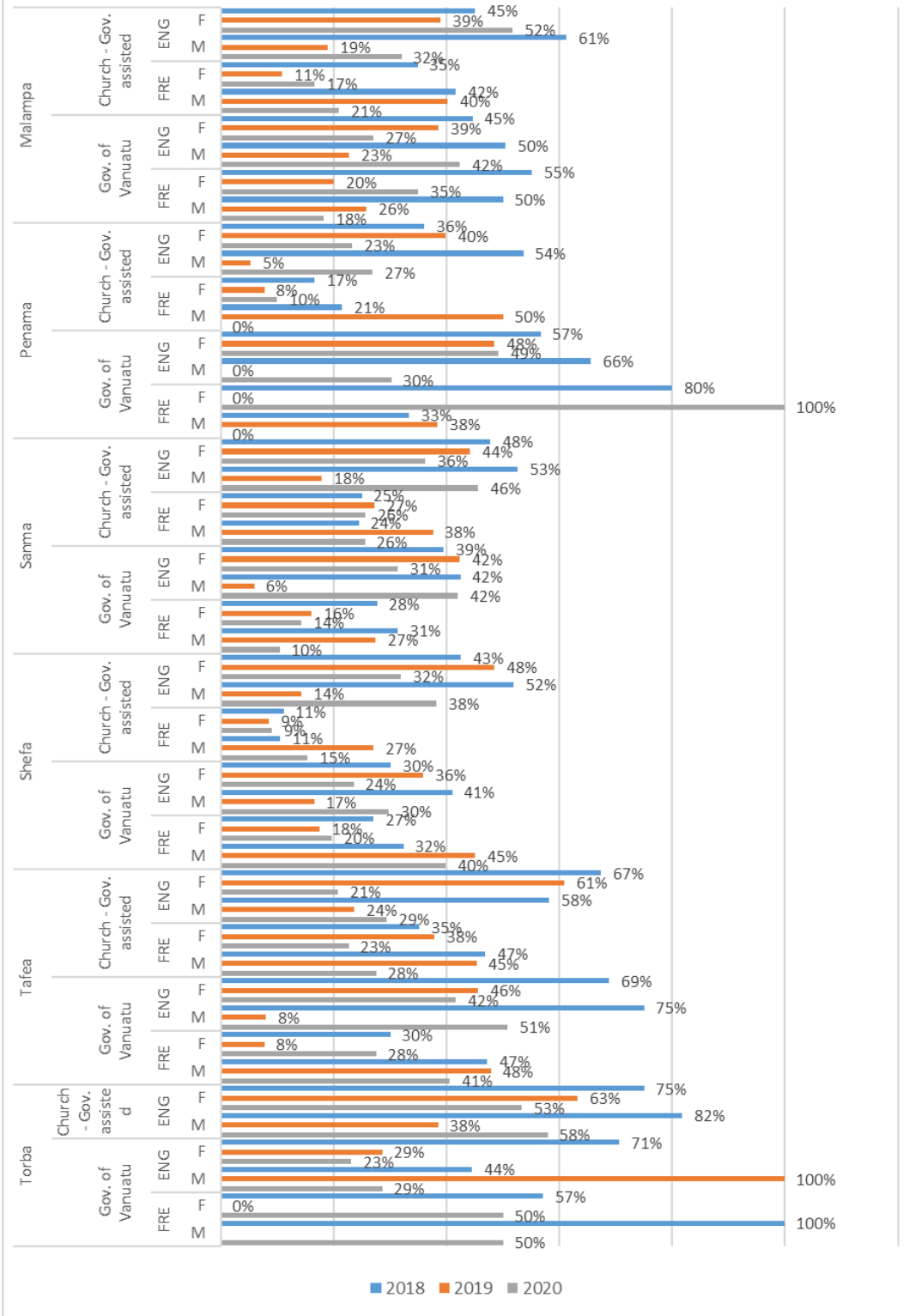

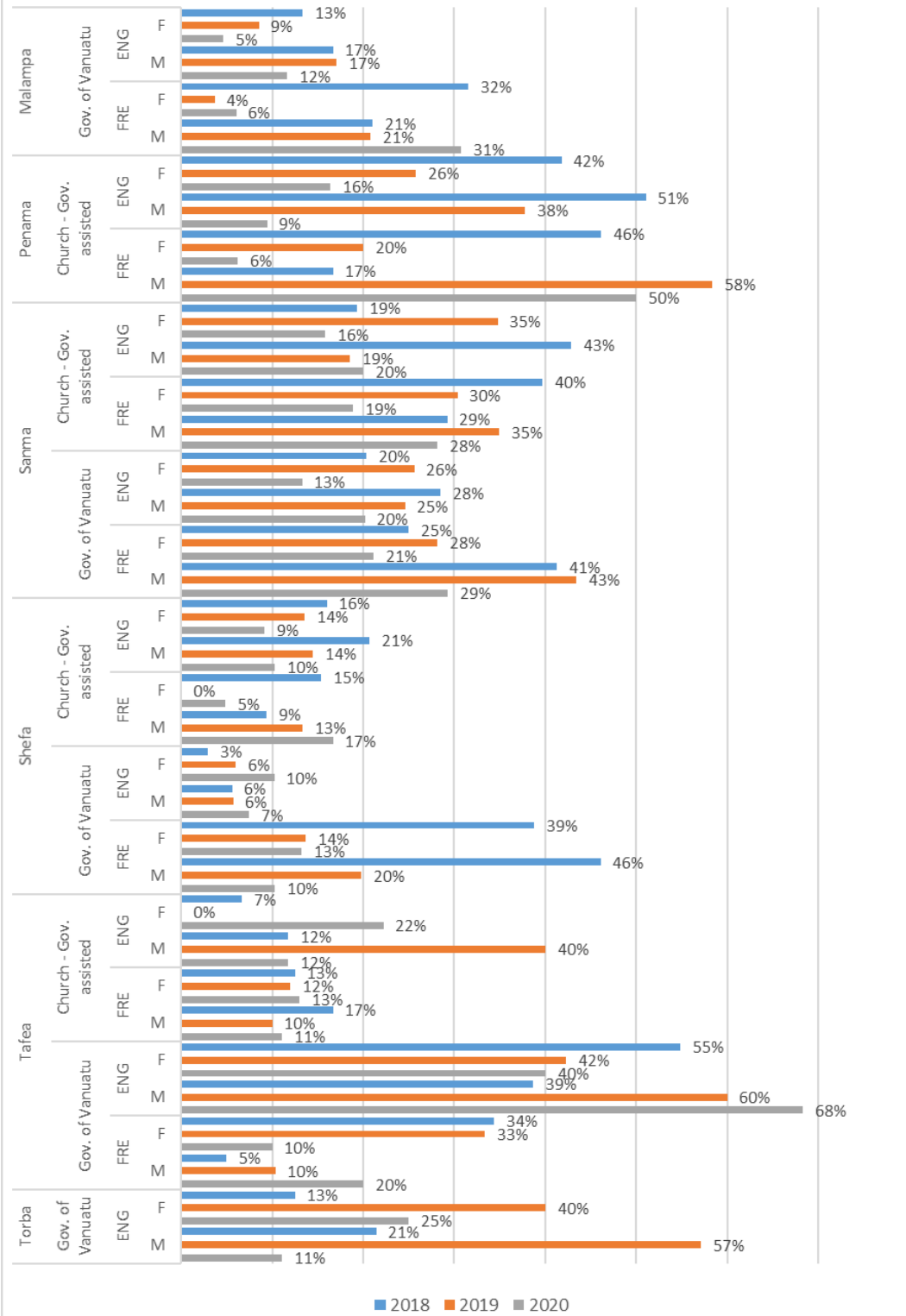

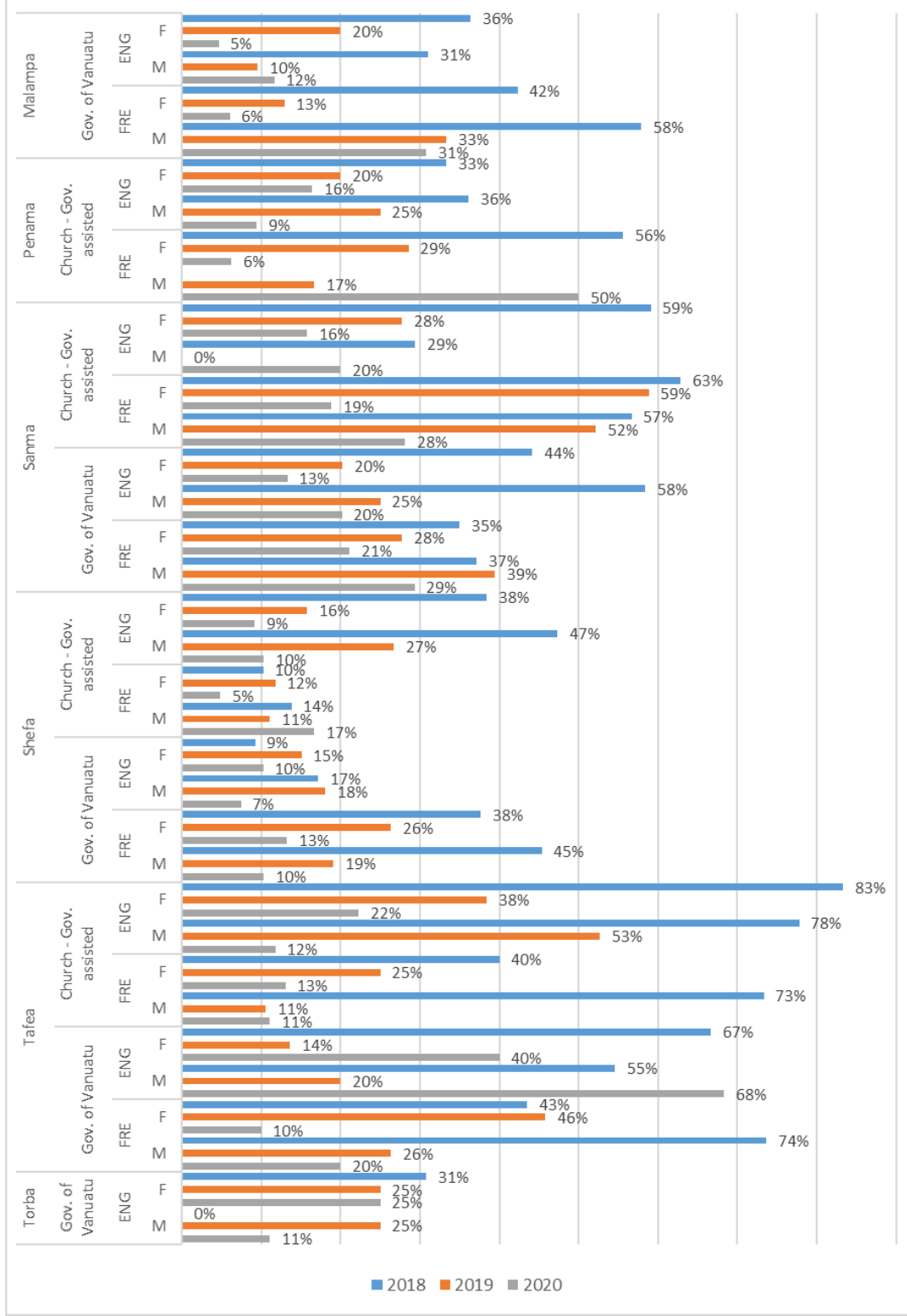

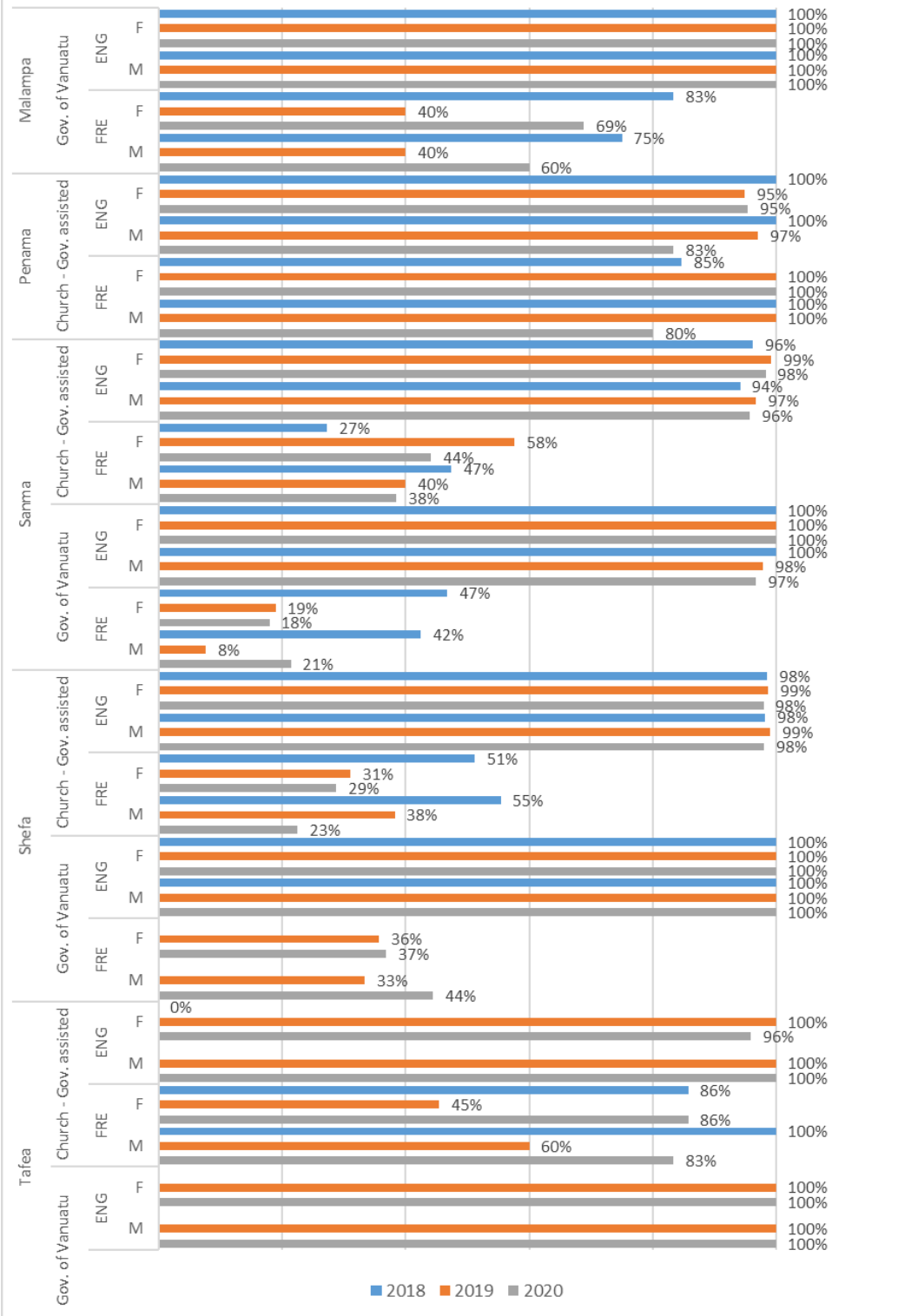

Secondary education dropout rates across education authorities, not Government assisted Churches and Private, by gender, by province, by language of instruction, by Year level, 2018, 2019, 2020

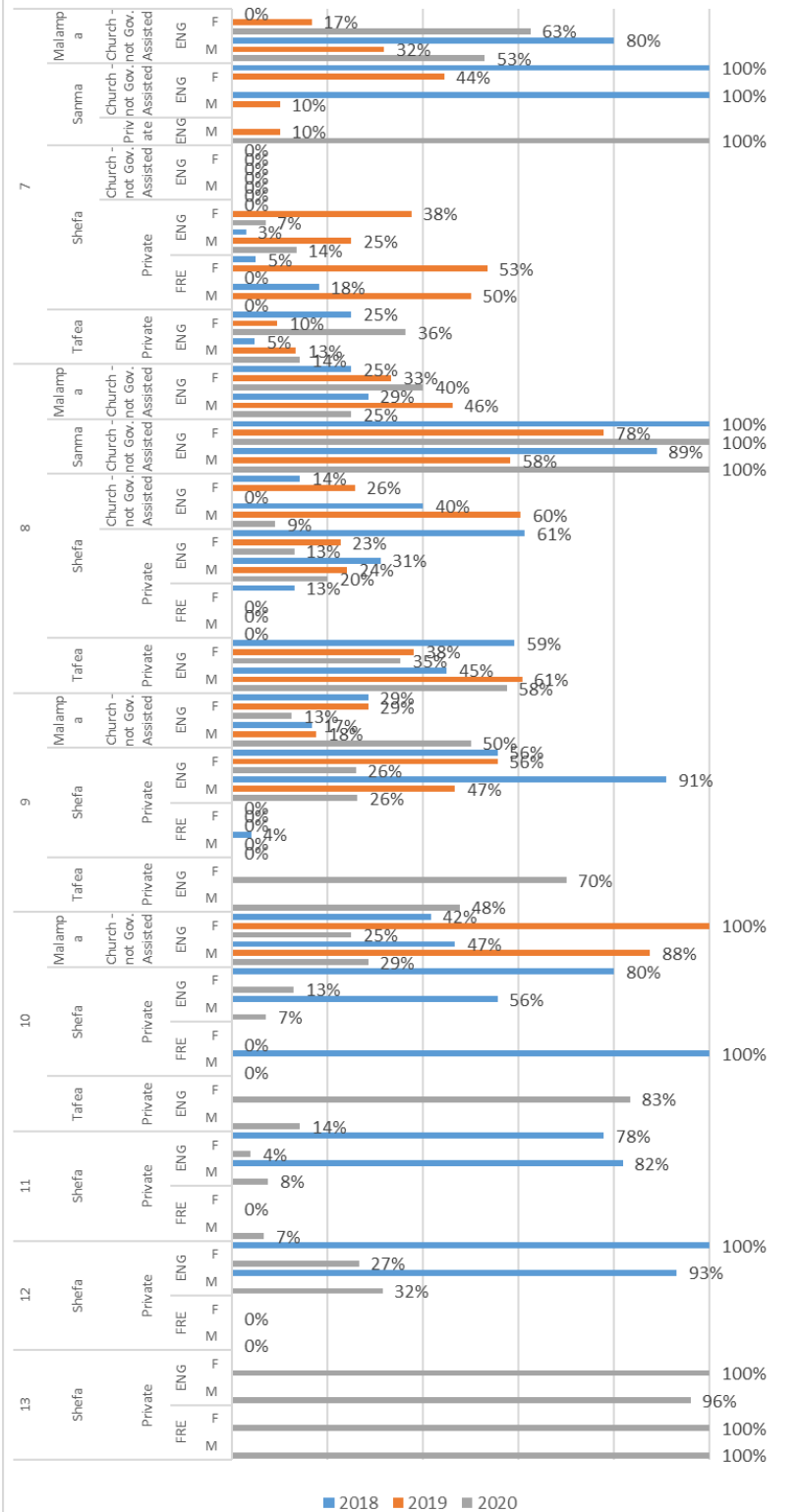
