

### 1.6.2 Number of secondary schools, by province and education authority - 2018, 2019, 2020

Since 2018, four types of authorities support the development of Secondary Education in Vanuatu with a representation average from 2018 to 2020 of 52.33% mainly funded/supported by Government of Vanuatu, 41.22% by Church government Assist, 5.38% by Private and 1.08% by Church (Non Government Assist).
