

1.8.4 Frequency of non-compliant ECCE schools, by province and criterion - 2018, 2019, 2020

The grants criteria for compliance is measured through five pillars which are: reporting on Audit Issue, Financial Issue, School Council Issue, Enrolment Plan and School Improvement Plan. It has been observed that the total number of non-compliant schools was records the highest in 2019 in all five pillars. Nevertheless, an improvement occurred in 2020 with a declining number of schools for all provinces on all pillars reported.

Since 2018, the highest frequency for non-compliance was reported under the financial pillar where the highest number of non-compliant schools were observed. However, the number of the non-compliant schools over the years was observed to improve significantly (decreased number of non-compliant schools) by 18% reaching 31 schools in 2020 out of 38 schools reported in 2018. The non-compliant schools are observed to be the highest in Shefa province and lowest in Malampa from 2018 until 2020.
