

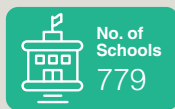


2021 Education Key Indicators

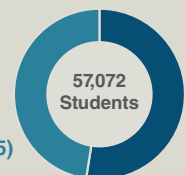

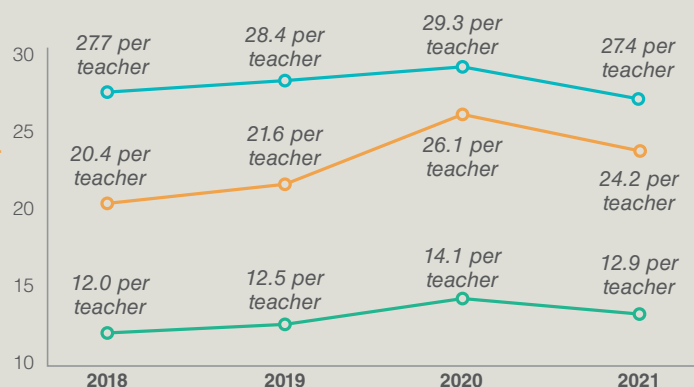

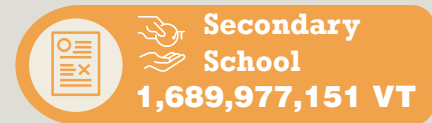

Grant allocations in 2021

58% contributions from the Government of Vanuatu

42% contributions from the donor partners



The Government of Vanuatu only pays grants for registered government and non-government assisted schools. Non-government (private) schools received a one-off grant in 2021. In Early Childhood centres, grants are only paid for 4 and 5-year-old students.
