

Vanuatu Education Support Program (VESP)

VESP is looking for the following individual to occupy the two (2) positions:

An Architect/Building Technician and an Assistant Building Surveyor

The Program

VESP is a program of support for key education initiatives being implemented by the Ministry of Education and Training (MoET). The program includes a strong focus on improving literacy and numeracy outcomes in the early years of primary education. One of the proposed strategies for achieving these outcomes is the provision of locally relevant and efficient facilities and equipment. VESP is supported by development partners under a Joint Partnership Arrangement between the Governments of Vanuatu, Australia and New Zealand.

VESP is currently seeking applications for the two positions to assist the Facilities Unit of the Ministry of Education to conduct an assets survey of selected primary schools in Vanuatu. Infrastructure opportunities to contribute to the development of the education sector in Vanuatu

Both are Full time contracts to 31 December 2015 with the possibility of extension.

1. Architect / Building Technician (Job reference 492673)

The Architect / Building Technician will be based in Port Vila with regular travel within Vanuatu. He/She will assist with designing, preparing **design and detail drawings**, costing and site planning for primary school buildings. The Architect / Building Technician will also assist project surveyors to document school survey data. Travel to other islands for survey work or training purposes will be required occasionally and may involve flexible working hours.

We are seeking applicants with university qualifications in Architecture or Construction with a minimum of two years professional experience (or equivalent professional experience in the absence of formal qualifications). A good knowledge of the building industry in Vanuatu and working knowledge of ArchiCAD or AutoCAD drawing software is required for success.

2. Assistant Building Surveyor (Job reference 492674)

The Assistant Building Surveyor will be based in Port Vila with some travel within Vanuatu. He/she will work closely with the Architect / Building Technician and assist other team members in preparing **design and detail drawings**, Bill of Quantities and costs for primary school buildings. This position will support the measuring and drawing of surveys for selected primary schools and collating and documenting survey data. Travel to other islands for survey work will be required occasionally and may involve some after-hours work.

We are seeking applicants preferably with a certificate in Building Construction/ Drawing/ Surveying or similar, as well as some work experience. Good knowledge of computers including AutoCAD software is desirable and a positive attitude and willingness to learn is required for success.

These positions are open to Vanuatu nationals.
