BACKGROUND

Long time Challenge of MoET in terms of M&E.

- It is difficult to know if programs have succeeded or failed.
- Often because the expected results are not clearly articulated/stated or because of the absence of the results framework itself

What is a results framework?

- A simple definition of results is precisely; what is to be achieved through the project or a program
- A results framework is an explicit articulation or simple expression (graphic display, matrix, or summary) of the different levels, or chains, of results expected from a particular intervention within a project, program, or development strategy.

What is a result framework cont.

- The results specified typically comprise the longerterm objectives/Goals (often referred to as "outcomes" or "impact") and the intermediate outcomes and outputs that precede, and lead to, those desired longer-term objectives.
- By when—keeps measurable objectives in sight, helps monitor progress toward those objectives, and assists with adjustment and management of program implementation.

EXAMPLE: OVERVIEW OF THE RESULT FRAMEWORK PARTICULARLY FOR GOAL 1 (IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF EDUCATION)

Goal 1: Improve the quality of Education in Vanuatu

1.1 End-of-Program Outcome: Increase in the number of children and young people (boys and girls) in Vanuatu in Schooling Years 1-6 who achieve the national literacy and numeracy standard, and in Secondary Schooling Years 10, 12 & 13 who have achieved a national standard pass mark.

1.1.1 Intermediate Outcome: Increase in the number of children age 6 ready for Schooling Year 1, in Vanuatu

1.1.2 Intermediate Outcome: Increase in the number of schools with teachers implementing the new national curriculum for Schooling Years 1-13 using effective teaching and learning methodologies, including a focus on gender, social inclusion and special needs

1.1.3 Intermediate Outcome Increase the number of teachers who have nationally recognized teacher certification/qualification in Vanuatu

BENEFITS OF THE RESULTS FRAMEWORK

A well-constructed results framework is beneficial for monitoring, management, and evaluation in several ways:

- 1. It helps focus on specific outcomes
- 2. It highlights the key linkages in the theory of change that underpin the intervention
- 3. It helps establish an evidence-based approach to monitoring and evaluation.
- 4. It helps measure progress toward strategic objectives
- 5. It helps achieve strategic objectives /goals

USES OF RESULTS FRAMEWORK

The advantages of using results frameworks translate to an array of applications for practitioners or others pursuing development objectives;

- Planning
- Consensus, coordination, and ownership.
- Management
- Communication and reporting
- Evaluation
- Harmonization
- Learning from experience
