

1.2.13. Primary education repetition rates by province, sex, education authority and year level - 2018, 2019, 2020

An increasing trend is recorded in the primary education repetition rates from 2018 to 2020 in each year level and gender (chart– 1.2.13.a).

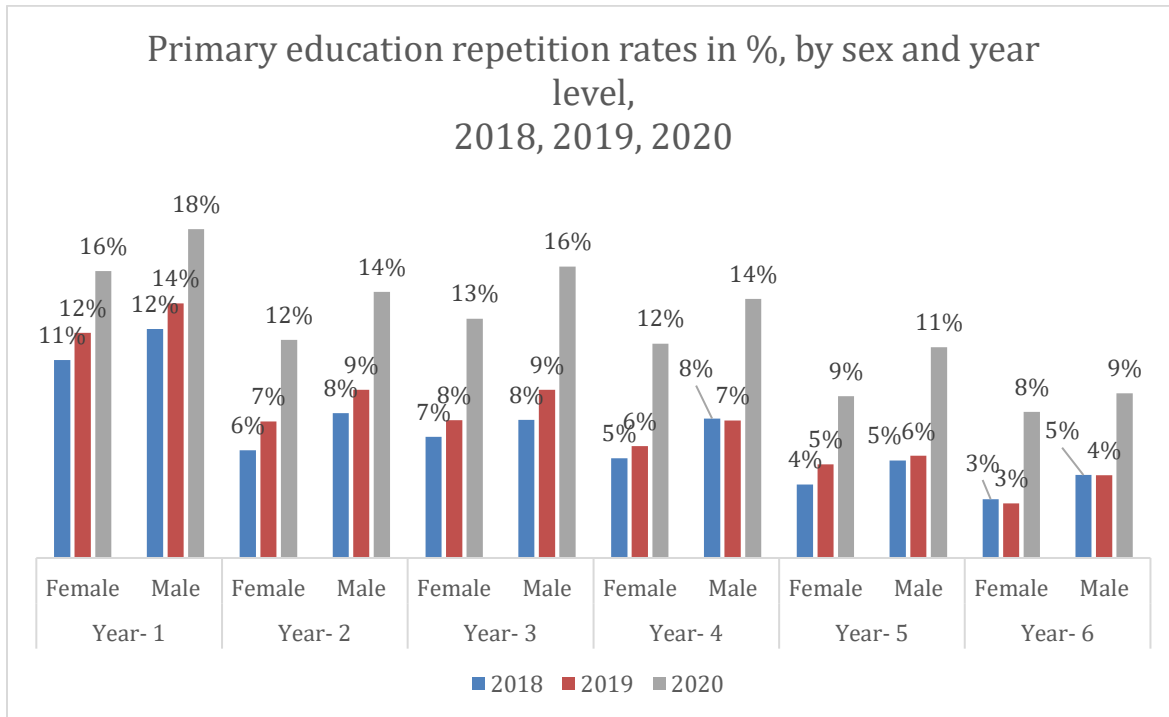

The increasing trend in the primary repetition rates within each year level for both sex is observed at province level with few exceptions (i.e.females in Torba in year level 1, females in Penama in year level 5, see chart - 1.2.13.b and c).

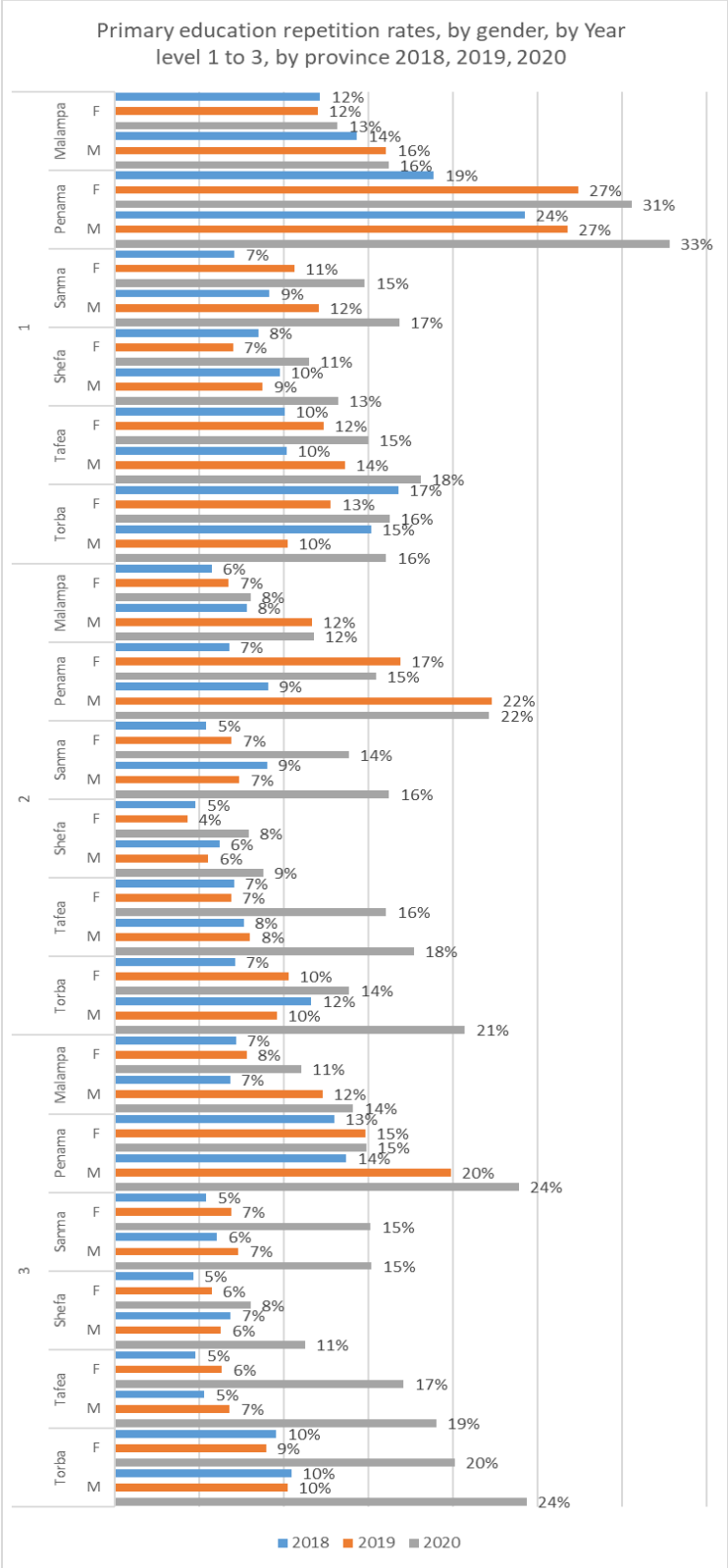

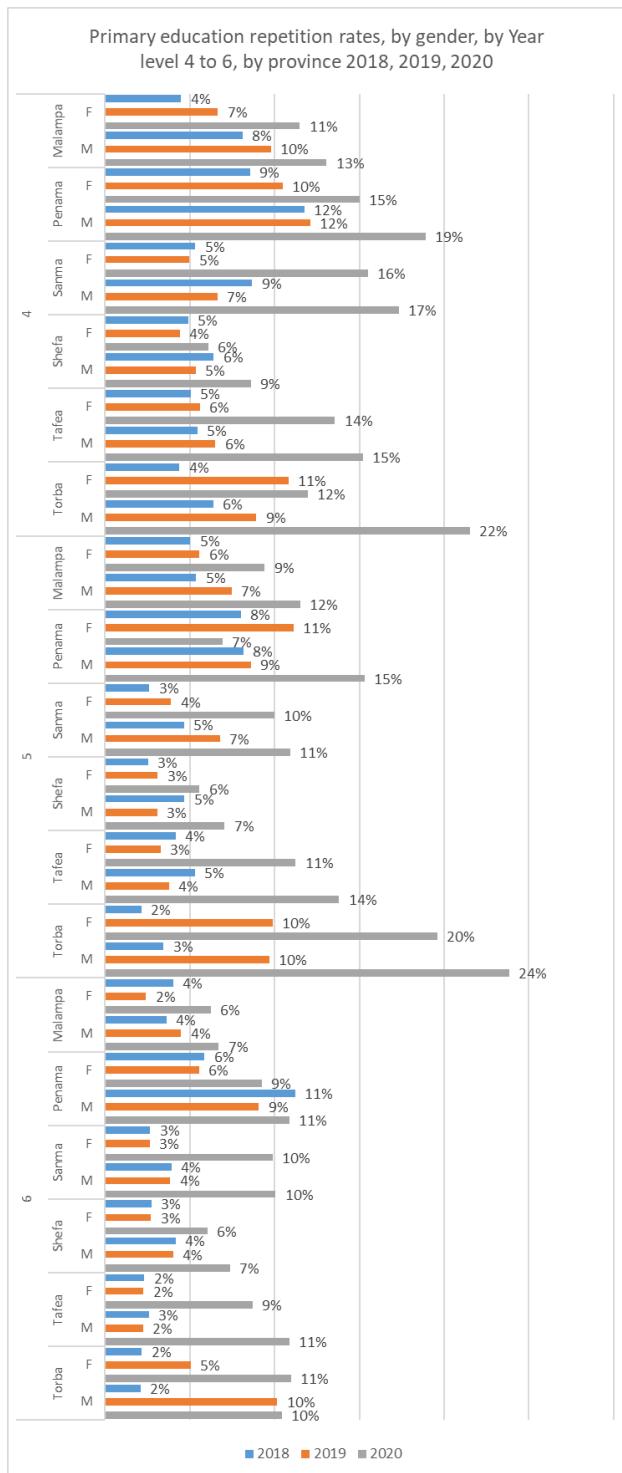

The increasing trend in the primary education repetition rates is observed at province level with two main education authorities as Government of Vanuatu and Government assisted Churches with few exceptions for each year level in certain provinces. It can be observed that the rates within schools Government of Vanuatu is lower than those governed by Government assisted Churches with few exceptions (Charts - 1.2.13d to 1.2.13.h)

The increasing trend in the primary repetition rates observed within year level 1 is observed in all provinces within both of the education authorities and sex except schools governed by the Government of Vanuatu in Malampa. The repetition rates within schools governed by the Government of Vanuatu are recorded comparably lower in all provinces except Shefa.

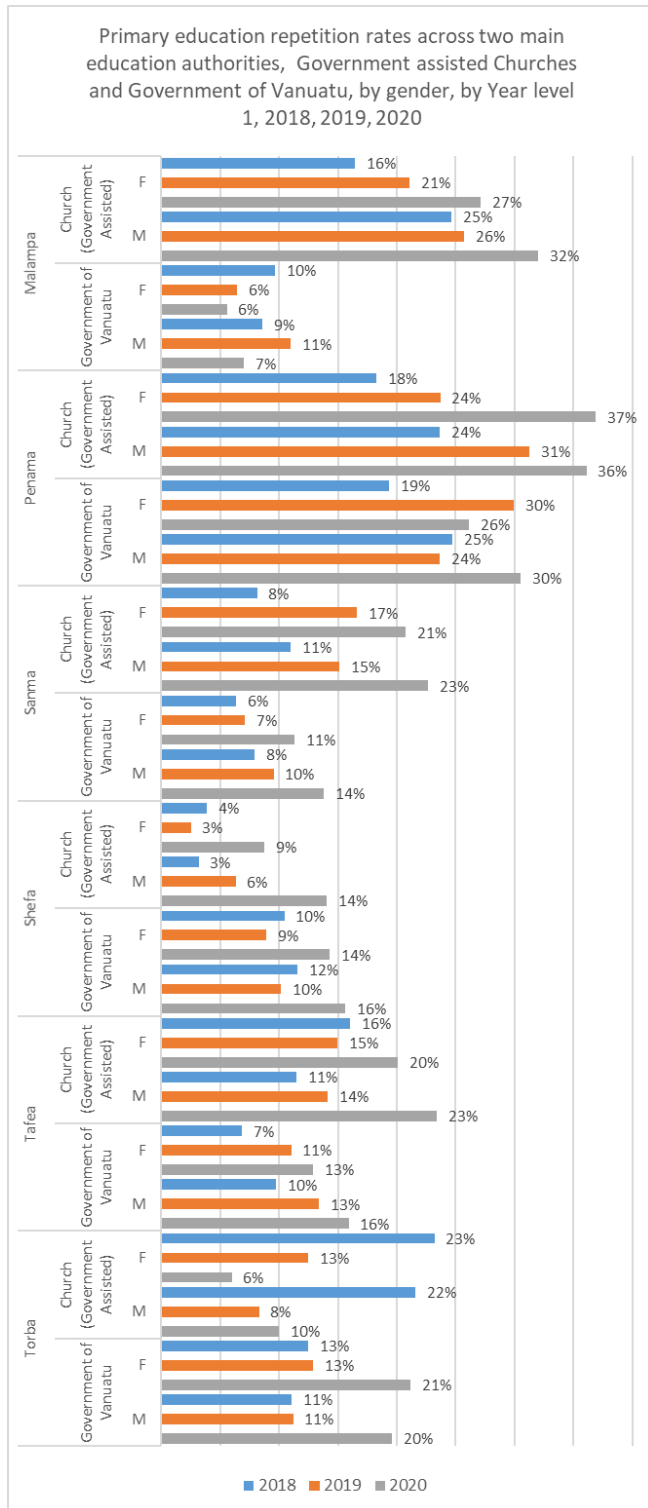
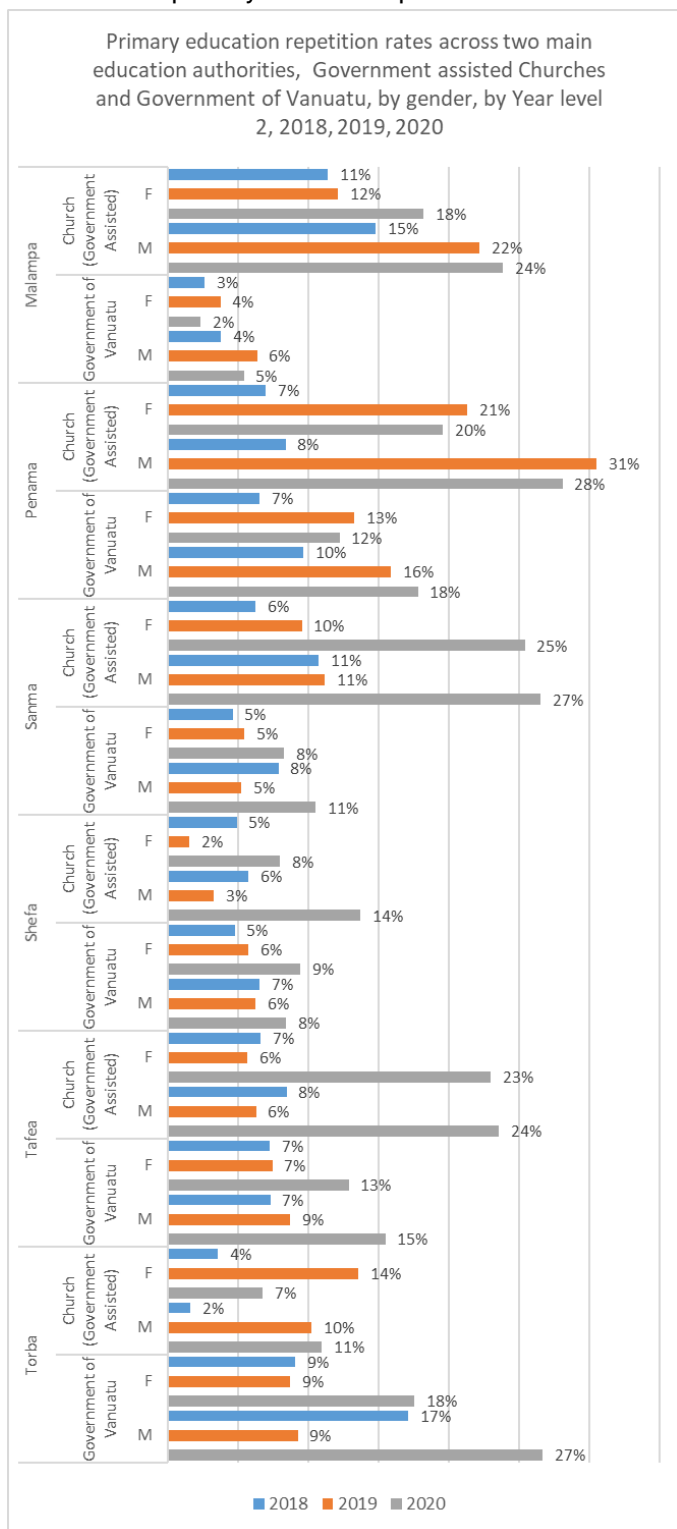


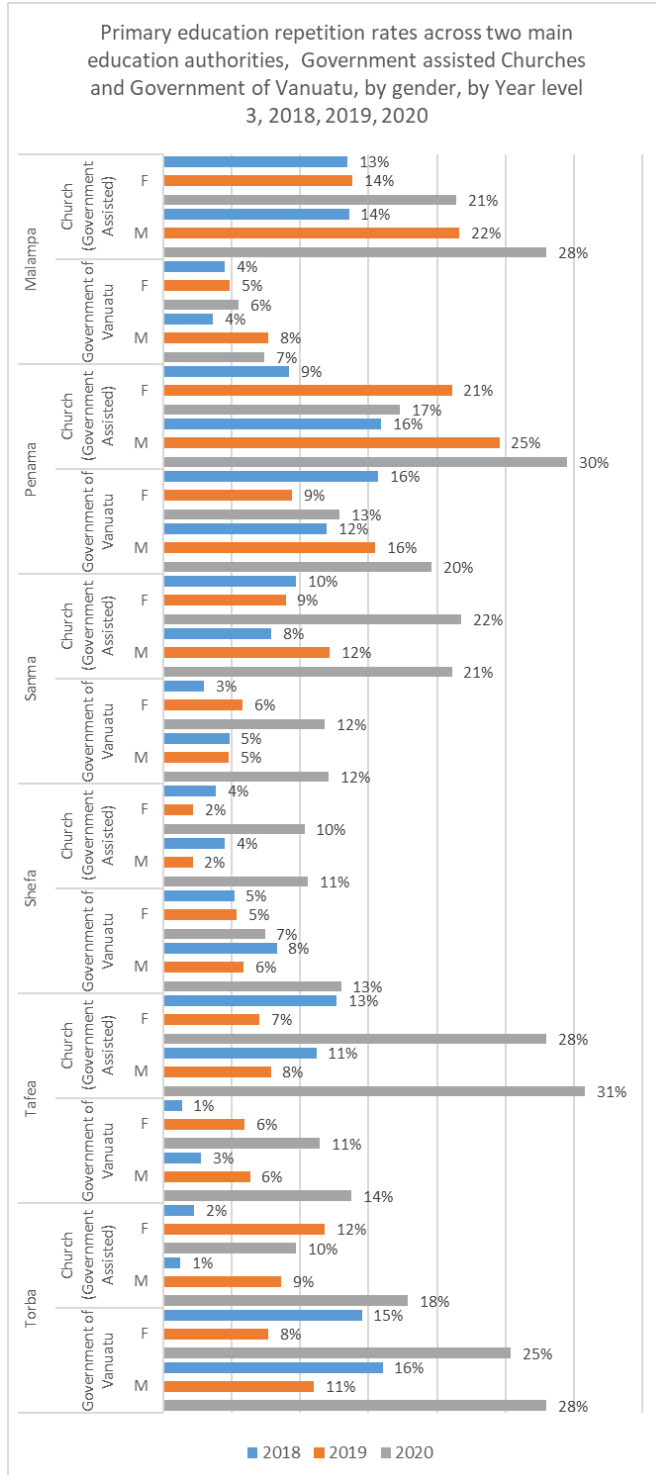

The increasing trend in the primary repetition rates observed within year level 2 is observed in all provinces within both education authorities and sex except schools governed by the Government of Vanuatu in Malampa. 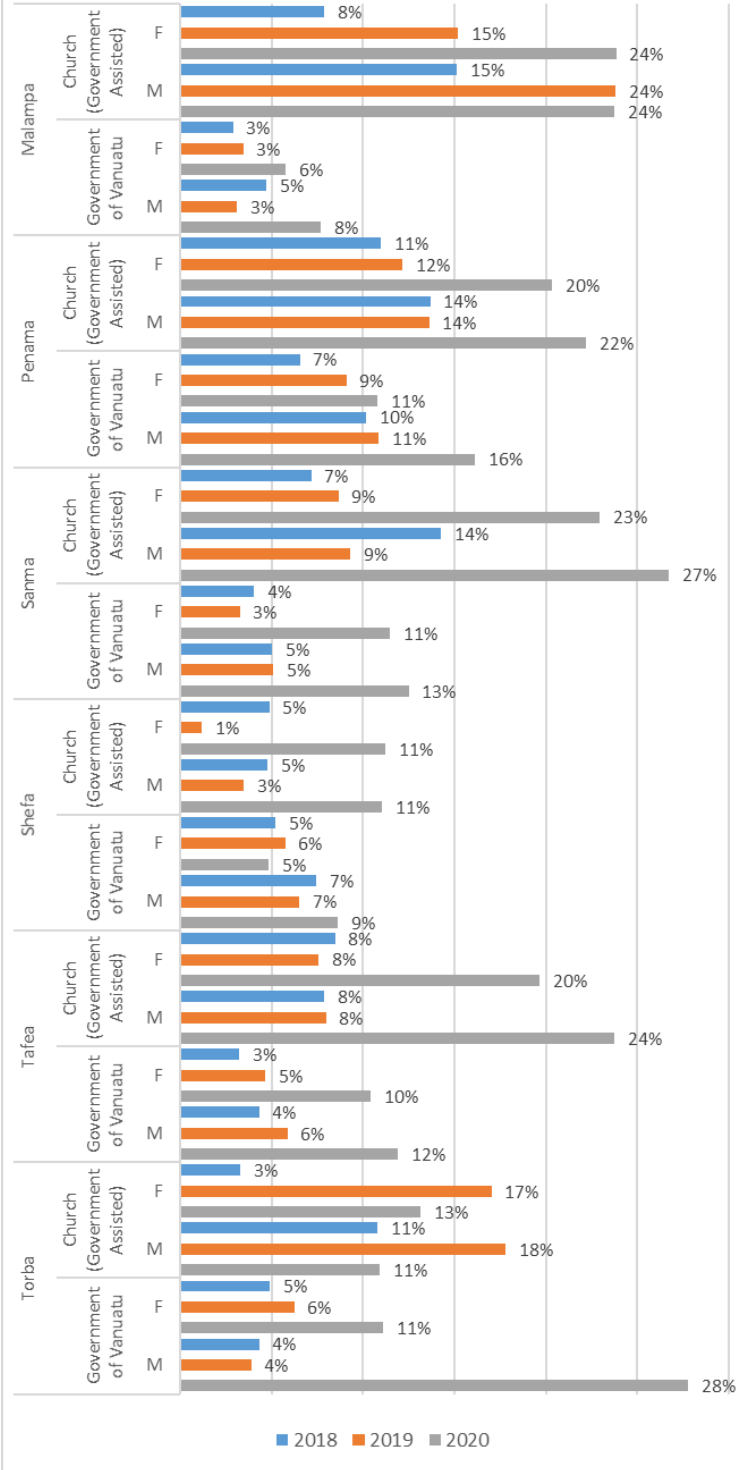
The primary repetition rate within year level 3 has an increasing trend for both education authorities and sex in all provinces except females in Penama province.

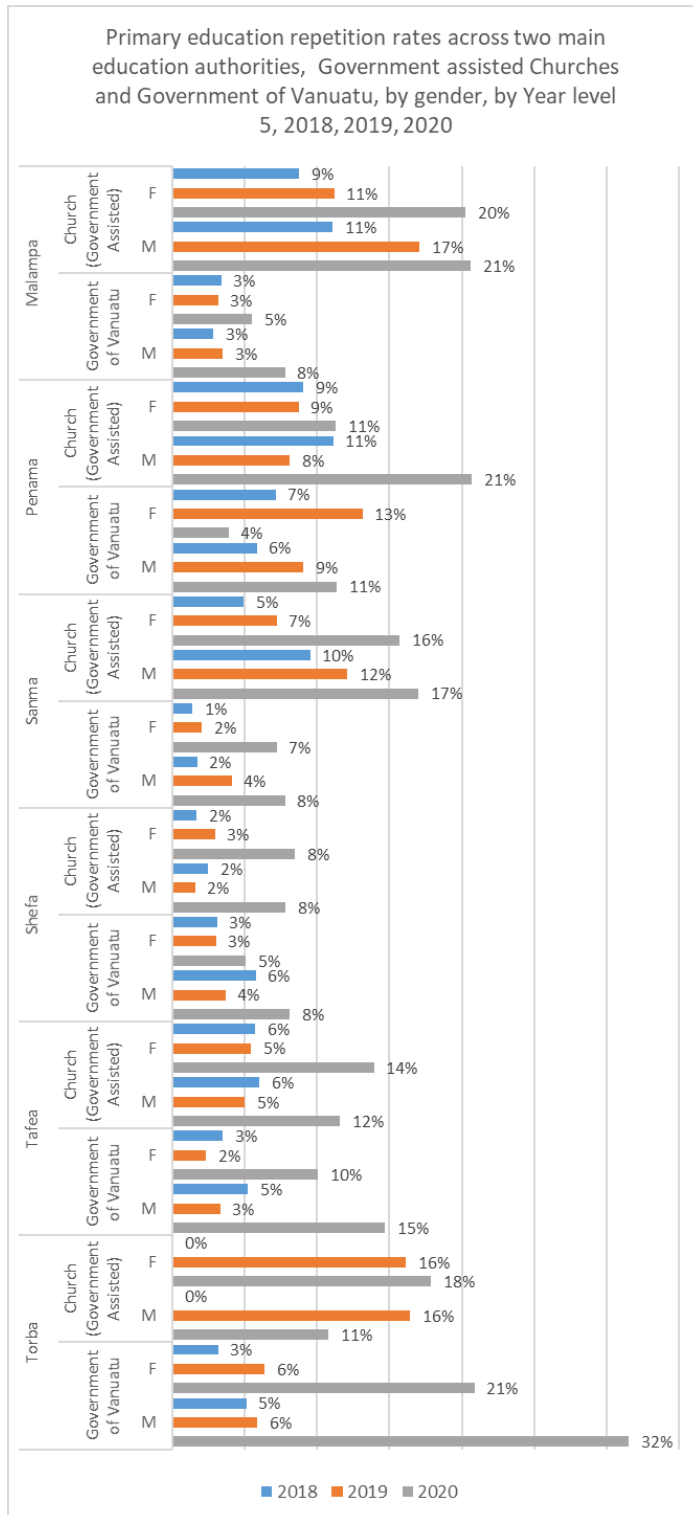

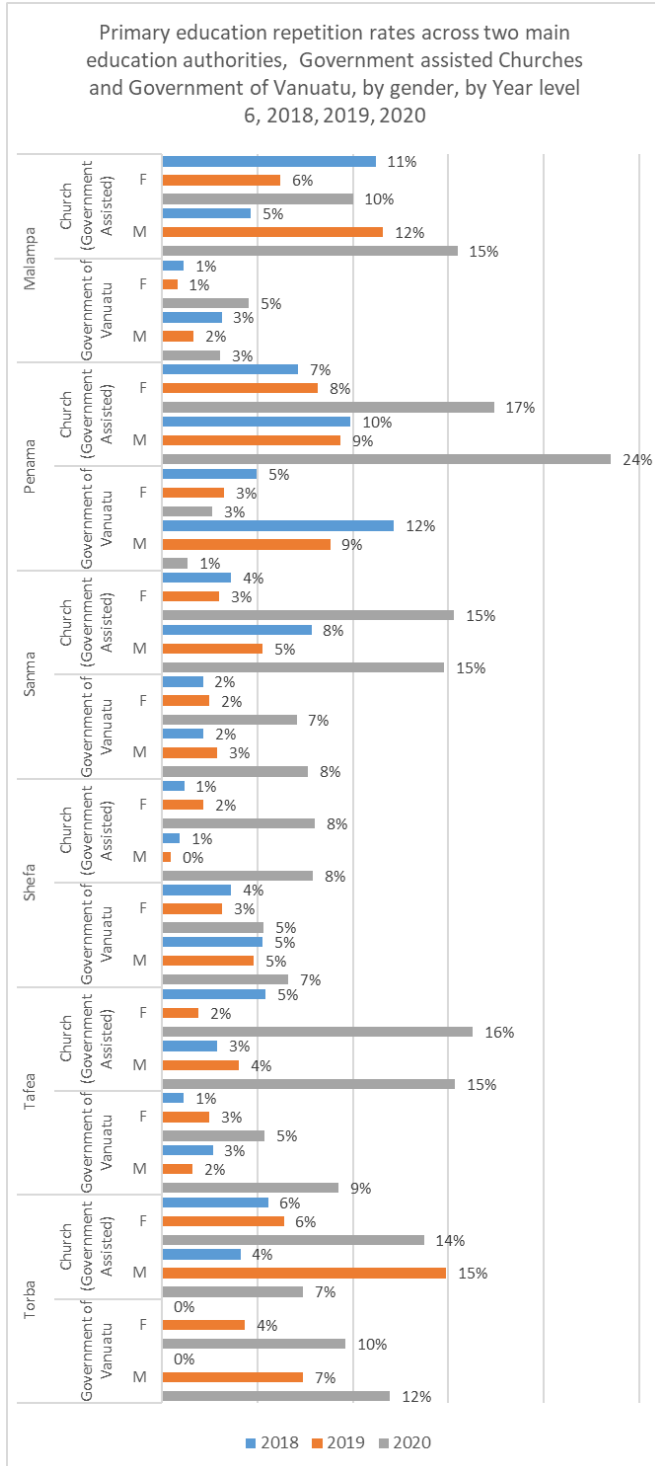
