

1.2.2. 2021 Population figures of primary education aged children, by sex and province based on National Census 2020

Gender disaggregation of the population figures of primary education aged children reveals that the number of males recorded within the 2020 census is higher than females in all provinces that the difference decreases to 1% in Malampa and Torba provinces.

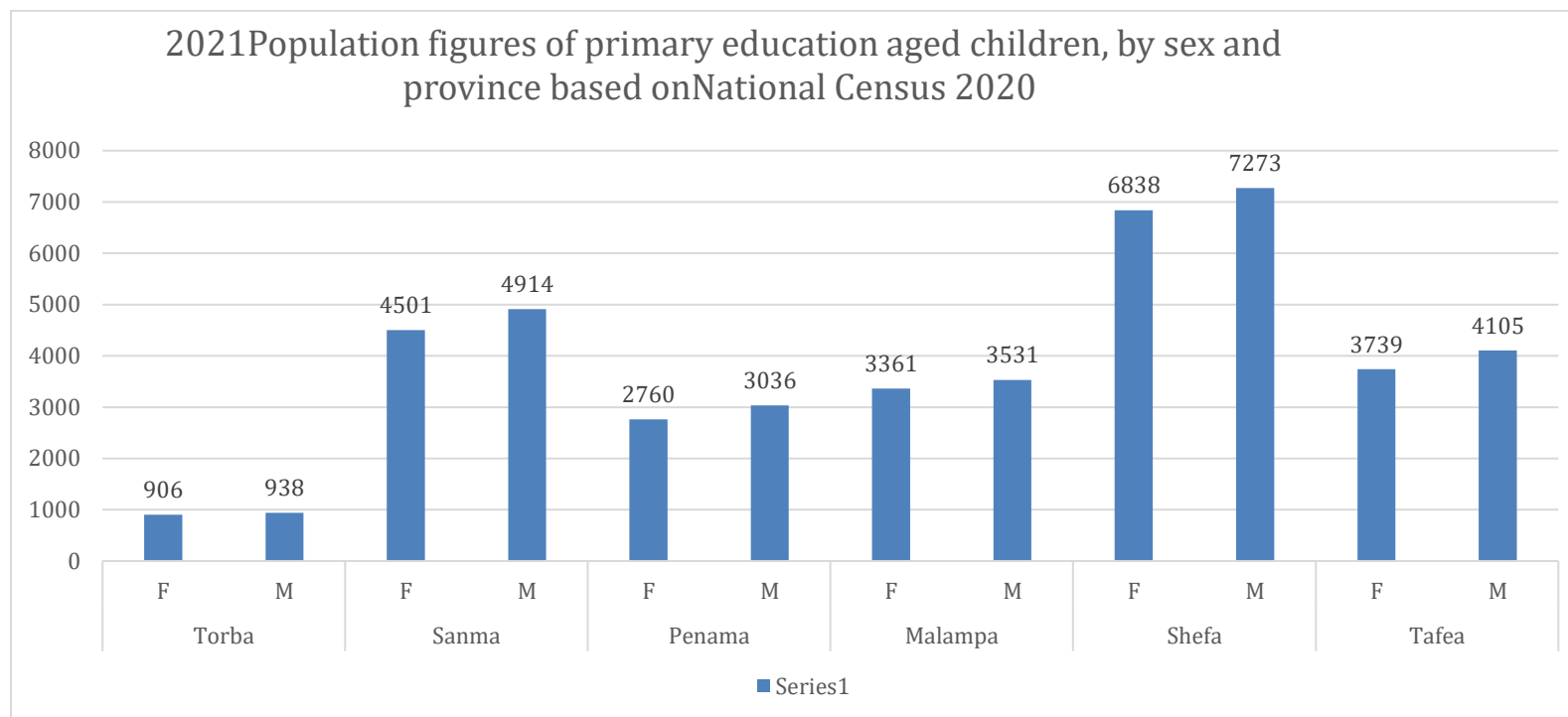
