

**1.3.21. Secondary education promotion rates, by province, sex, education authority, year level, language of instruction - 2018, 2019, 2020**

Secondary education promotion rates within both languages of instruction as English and French had an increase from 2018 to 2020 at country level and at province level, for both genders. While the promotion rate in 2020 within schools teaching in English at country level is 2% higher than those teach in French, the difference gets larger in certain provinces and gender.

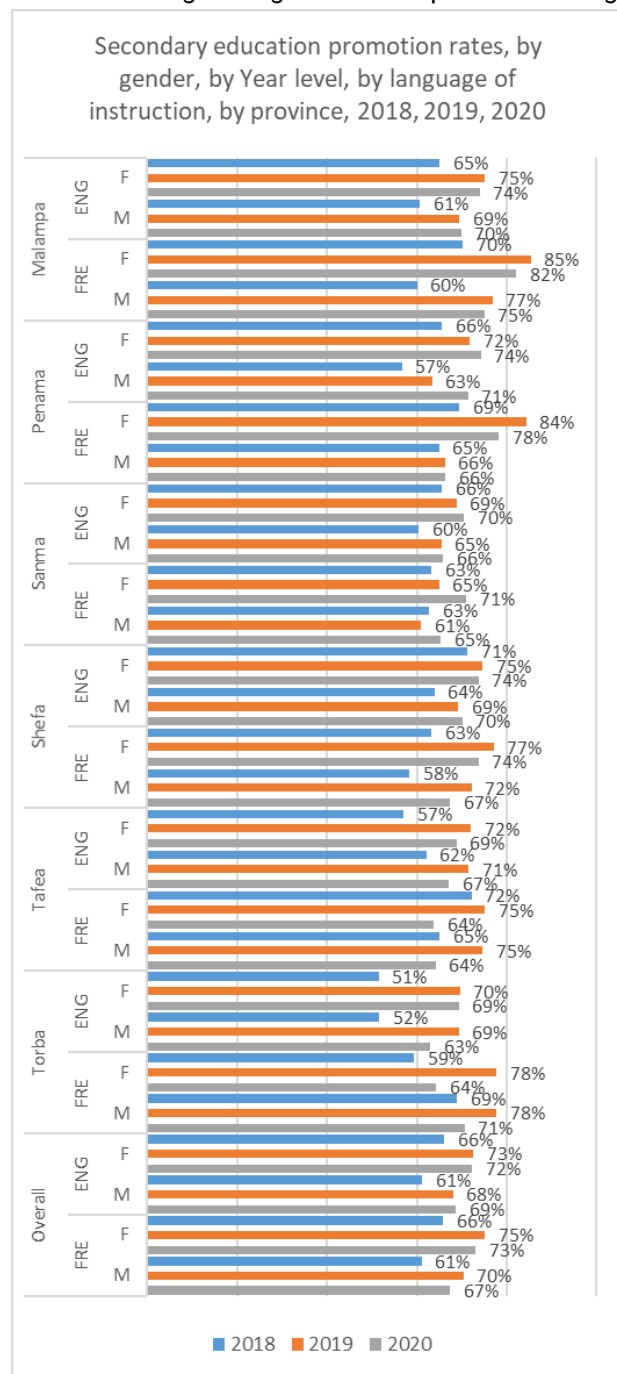

The increasing trend in the promotion rates is observed for both languages of instruction in each year level.

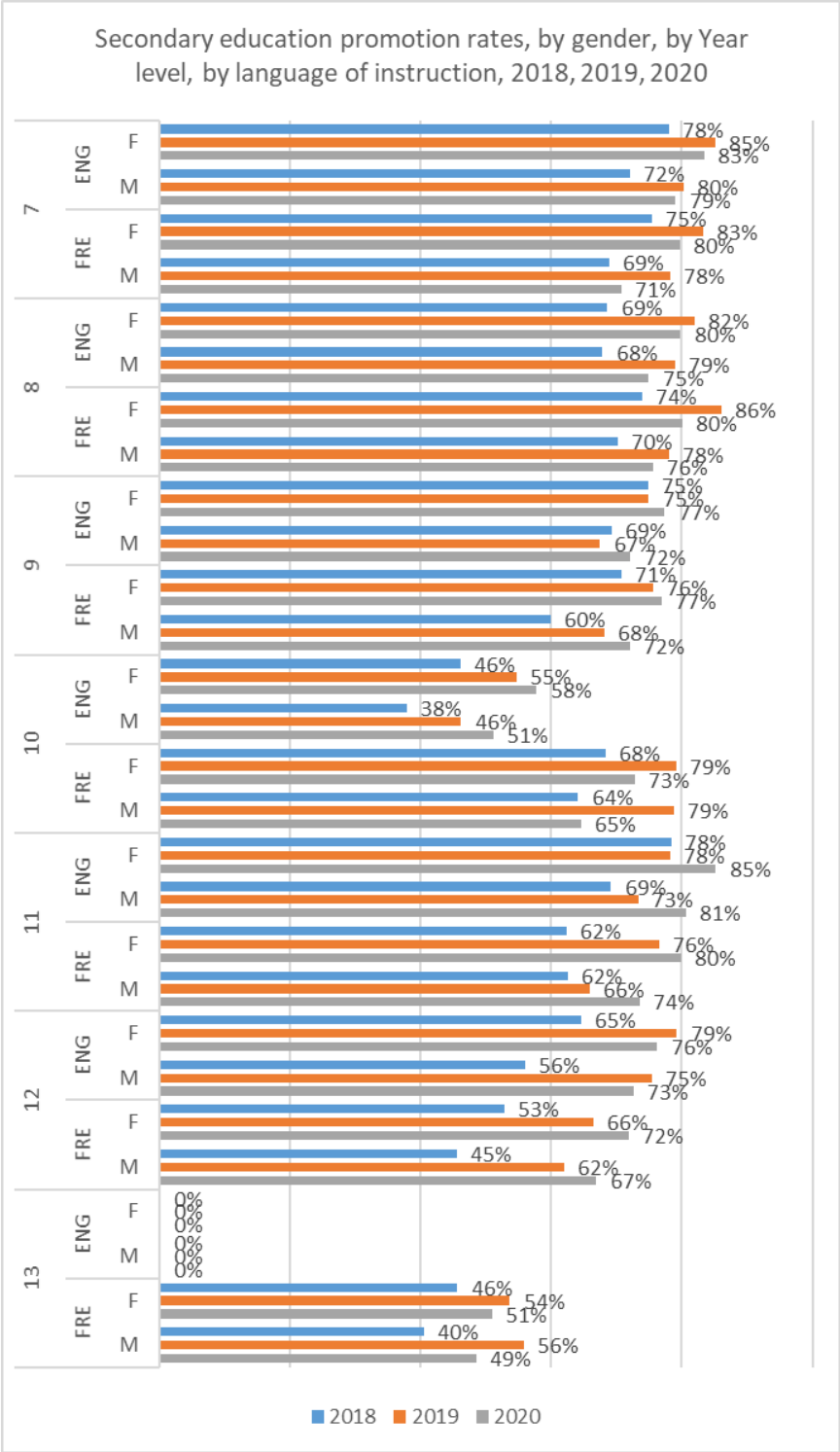

The increasing trend in secondary promotion rates are observed for both of the two main education authorities in year level 7 to 9 with following exceptions; females and males enrolled in year level 8 schools governed by Government assisted Churches teaching in French and males in year level 9 with same education authority and language of instruction.

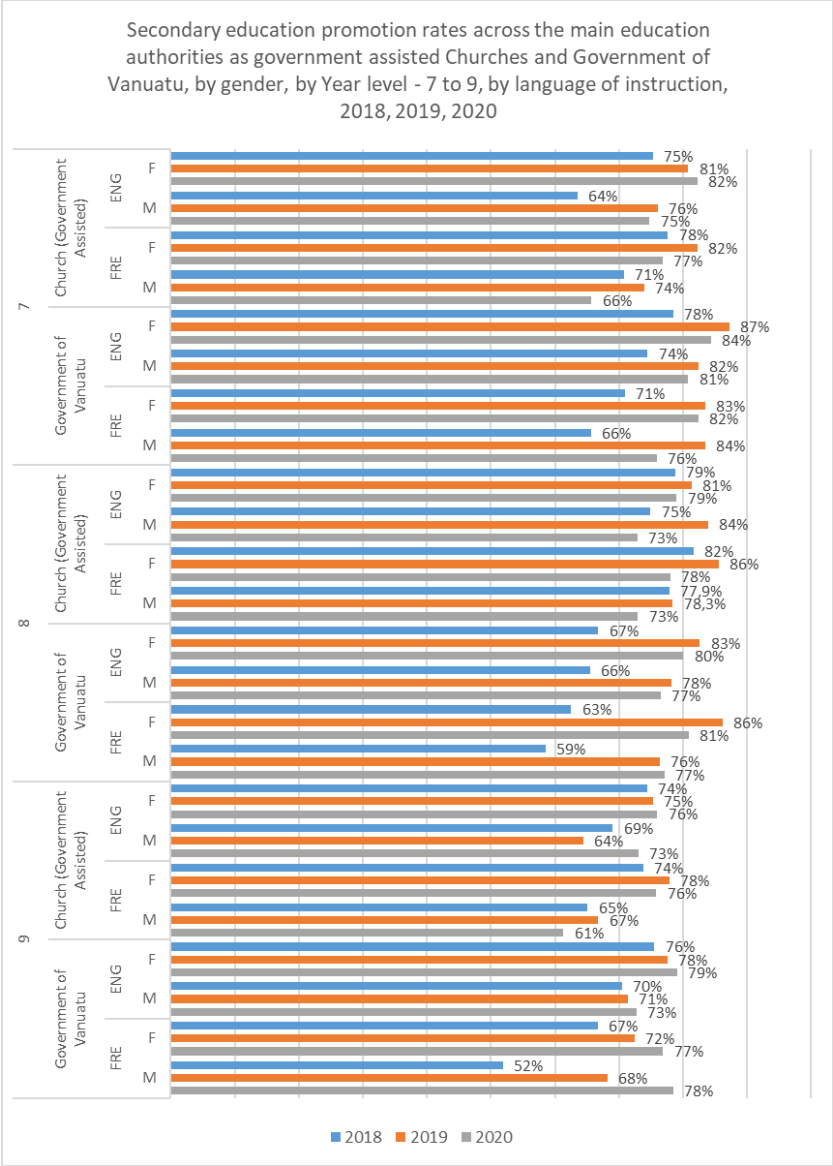

The increasing trend in secondary promotion rates are observed for both main education authorities in year level 10 and 11 with following exceptions; females and males enrolled in year level 10 schools governed by Government assisted Churches teaching in French and males in year level 11 with same education authority and language of instruction, and males in year level 10 enrolled in schools governed by the Government of Vanuatu teaching in French.

The increasing trend in secondary promotion rates are observed for both main education authorities in year level 12 and 13

Secondary education is available within both languages of instruction only within private schools where the promotion rates differ significantly between the two languages of instruction across the year levels with respect to the direction of the trend and the size of the changes in the rates from 2018 to 2020.

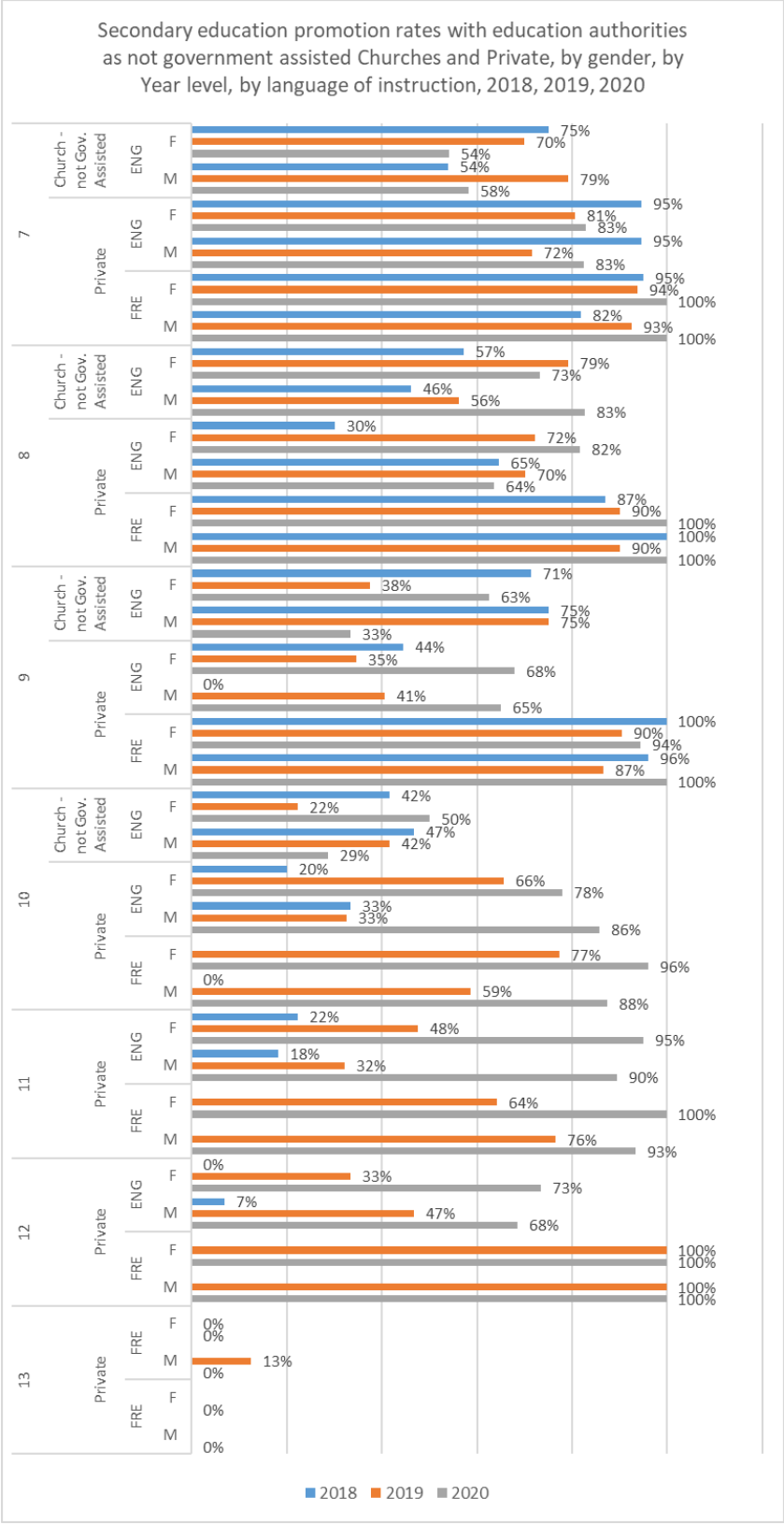

governed by Government assisted churches and French as language of instruction, compared to those governed by Government of Vanuatu and teaching in English.

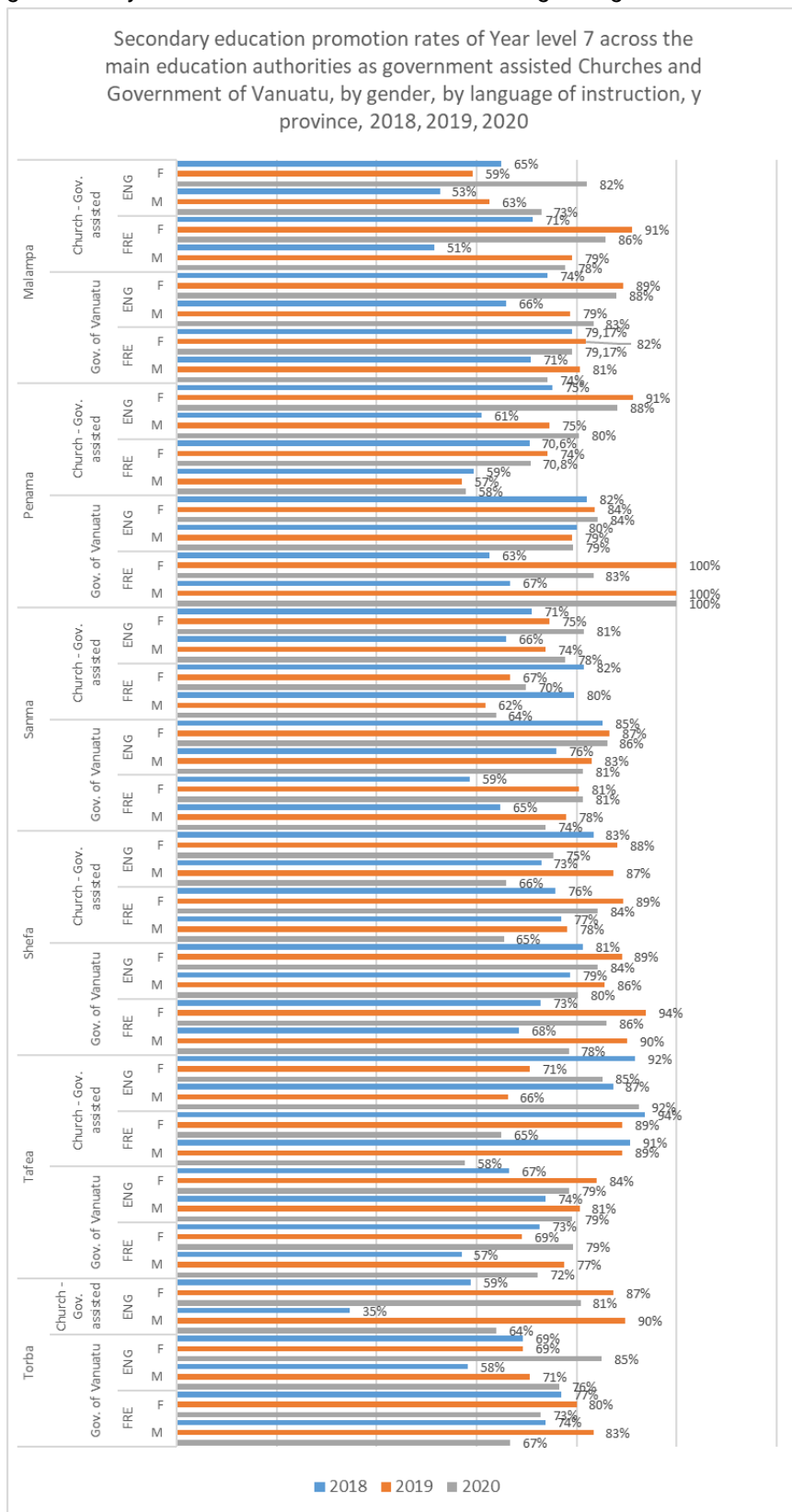

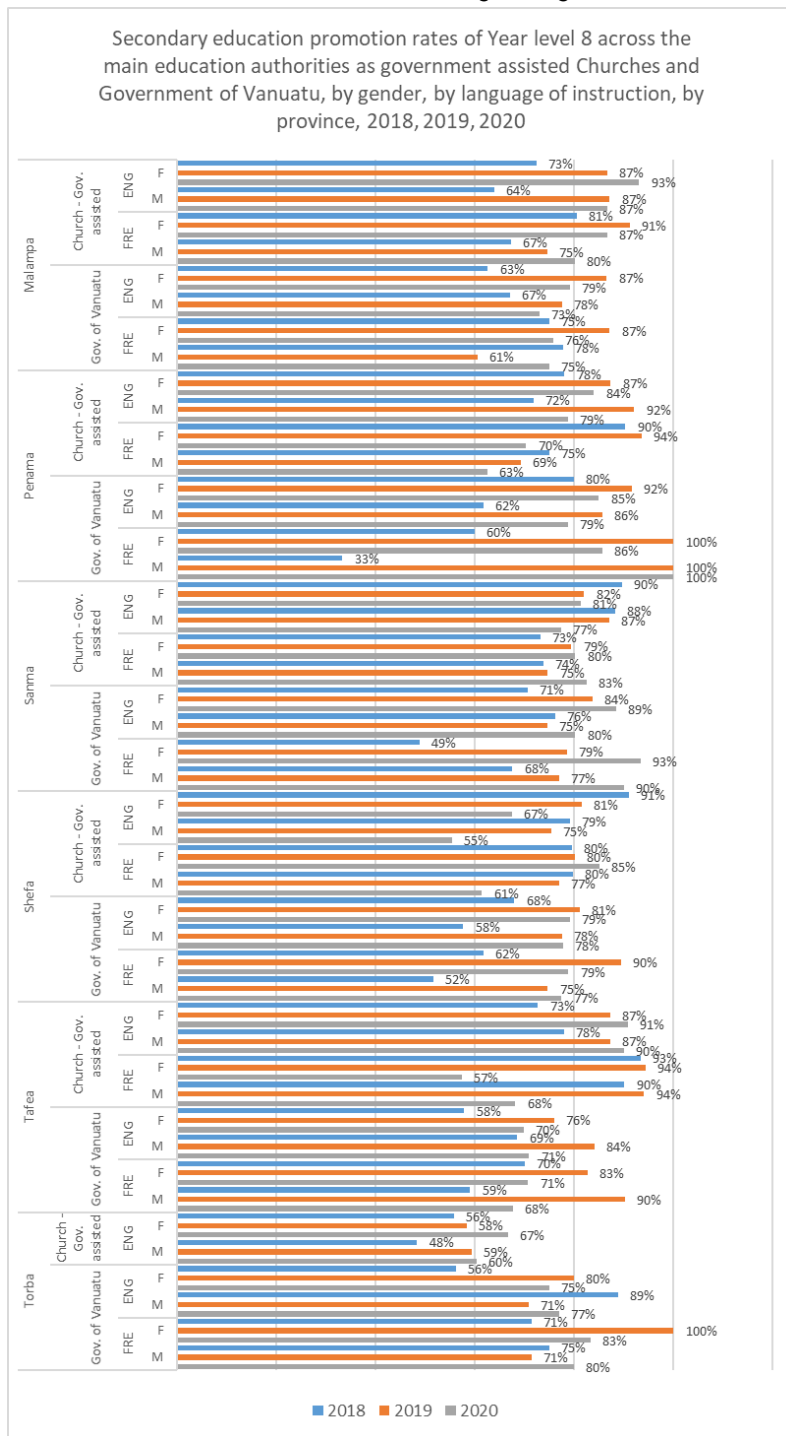

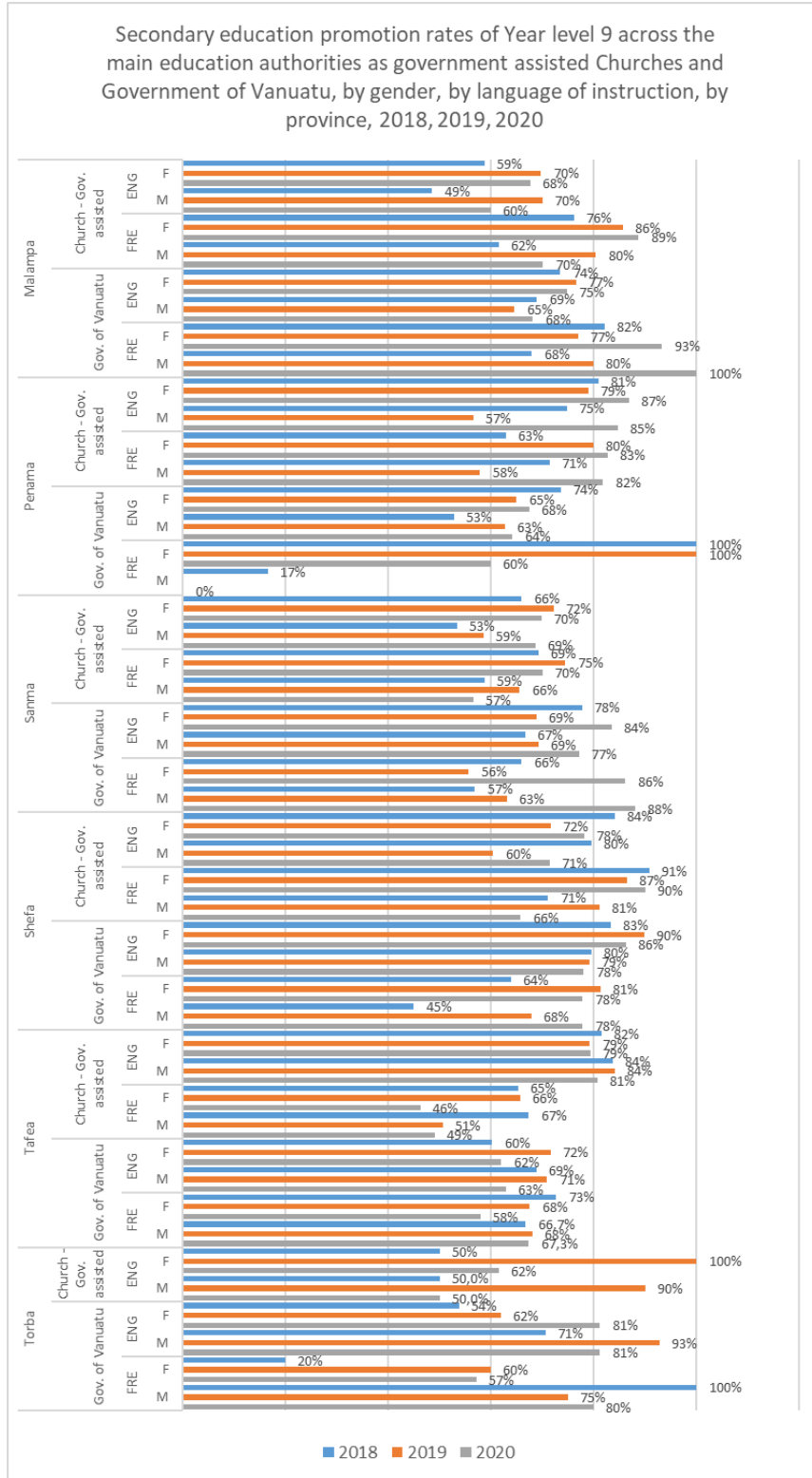

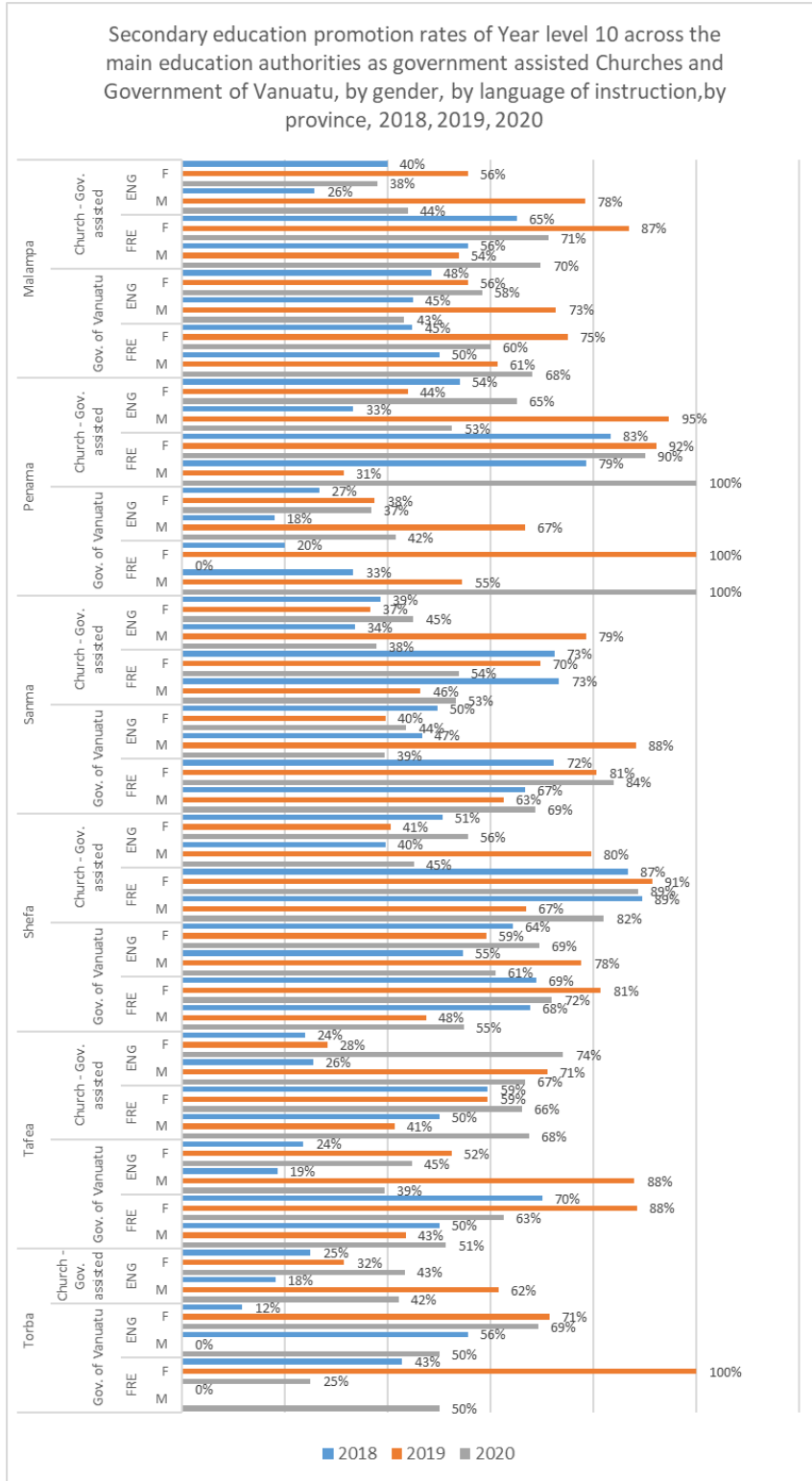

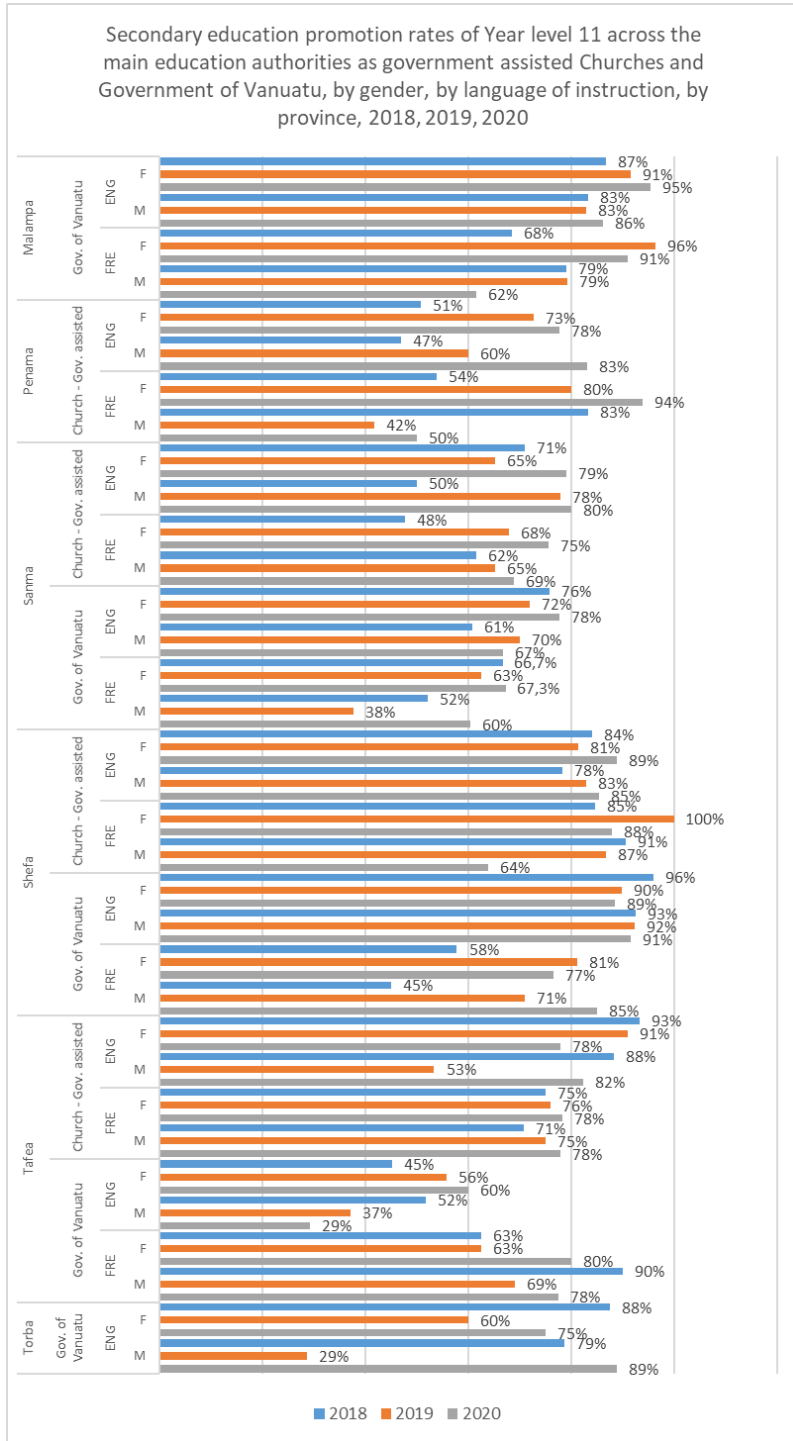

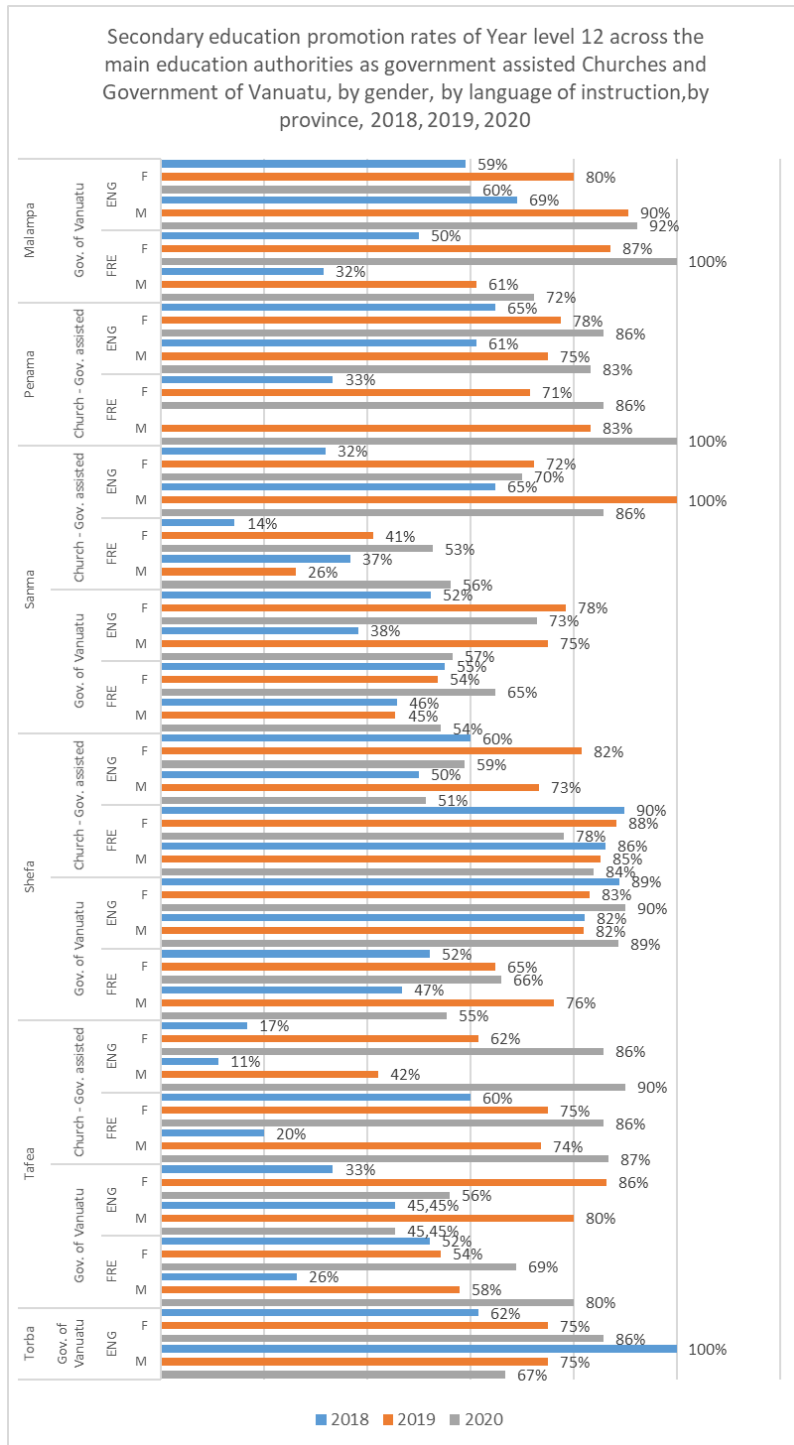

unavailability of the education in certain provinces and year periods (please see chart - XX below and table - AA for enrolment, promotion figures and the rates).

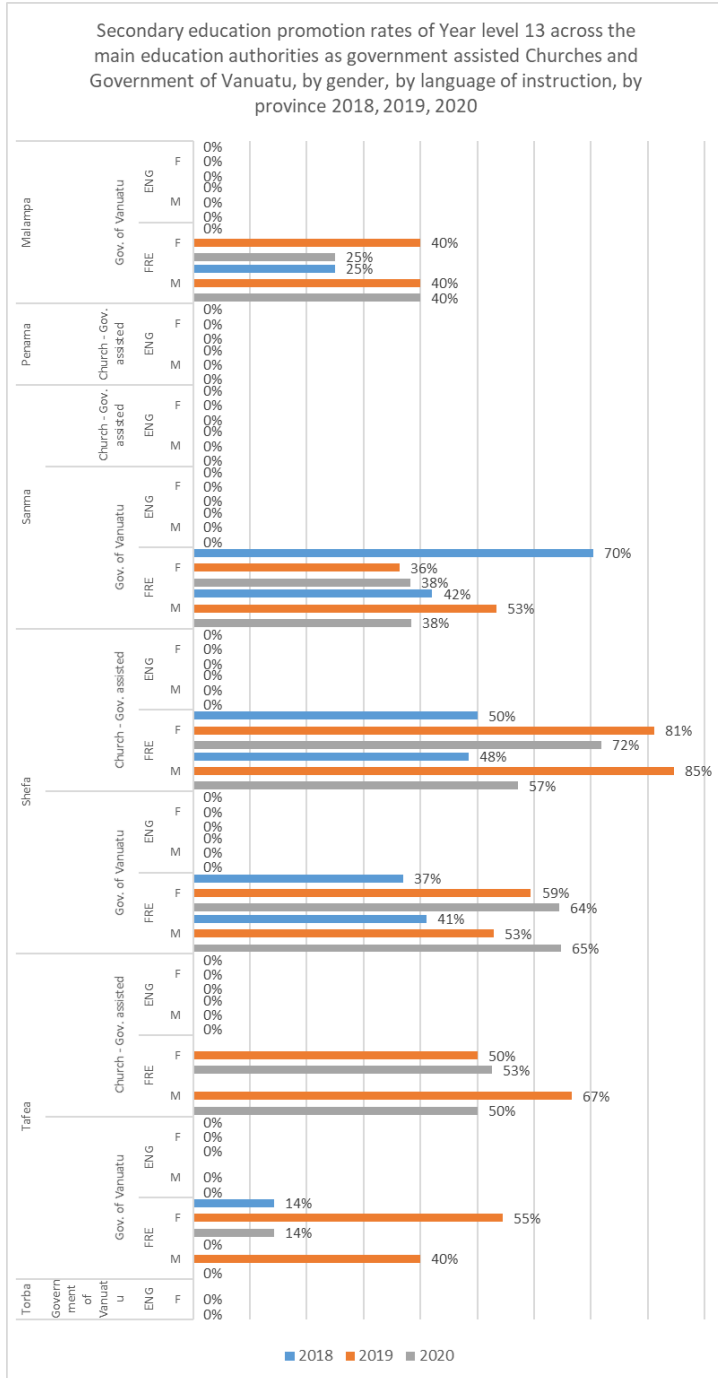
