## 1.9.1 Secondary schools receiving grant, by province. 2018, 2019, 2020

A slight gradual increase was recorded on the overall number of schools which were provided with financial grants. On provincial level, Shefa observed the highest number of schools receiving grants within the three years period on average of 21 schools and Torba as the least province was provided with grants 5 schools per year.
