

3.19 Number of students by sex graduated in each program at the National University of Vanuatu in 2018-2019

The number of graduated during 2018 and 2019 remained static within the same ranges. The gender representation also was stable for 45% for female graduates to 55% for male graduates. In 2019, the highest number of graduates were enrolled in Bachelor's degree in Economics and Social Administration (Face to Face) in comparison to 2018 which was Master's degree in Economics and Social Sciences.
