**Re: All Schools to Fully Resume Normal Operations from 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2022**

The Ministry of Education & Training (MoET) requests that all ECCE, Primary, Secondary schools and Tertiary institutions, throughout Vanuatu, must fully resume with normal teaching and learning operations from Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2022.

Further to my instructions dated 6<sup>th</sup> May 2022, on the Amendment of the 2022 School Academic Calendar, Implementation of SoPs and Pedagogy Review of Term One (1) lessons for schools, schools were required to use the term one holidays (*beginning Monday 9<sup>th</sup> to Friday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2022*), to trial their respective COVID-19 Standard Operating Procedures (SoPs), and at the same time undertake a pedagogy review for Term 1, and to assess the effectiveness of Home School Packages (HSPs), during the emergency period.

Thank you to the schools which have submitted and currently implementing their SOPs. For those who are still yet to submit their SOPs please complete your SOPs and submit to the respective Provincial Education Offices, by the end of this week.

In addition, I would like to remind each Principal, that the Ministry looks forward to receiving your respective feedback on the pedagogy review for Term 1, and on the effectiveness of HSPs used, during the emergency period. The required deadline to submit your respective reports will be Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> May 2022.

The Ministry of Education & Training wishes to assure all parents, guardians, caregivers and the general public that the principals and school councils will ensure that school environment are always safe for students to resume their normal classes.
