

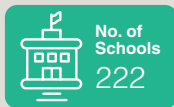


2020 Sanma Education Key Indicators

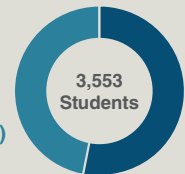

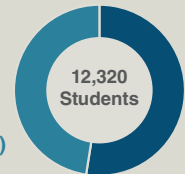

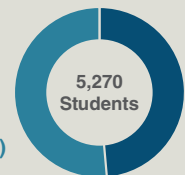

Actual student teacher ratio per school type

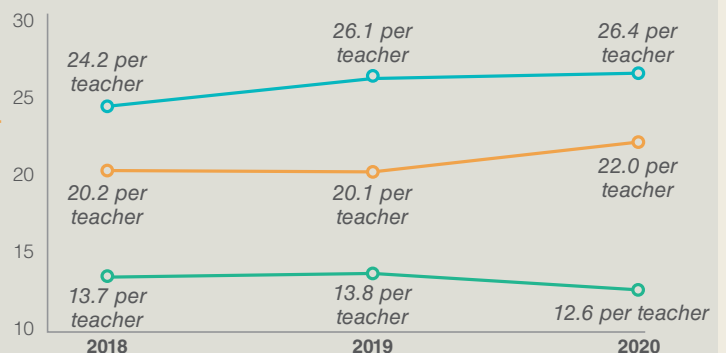

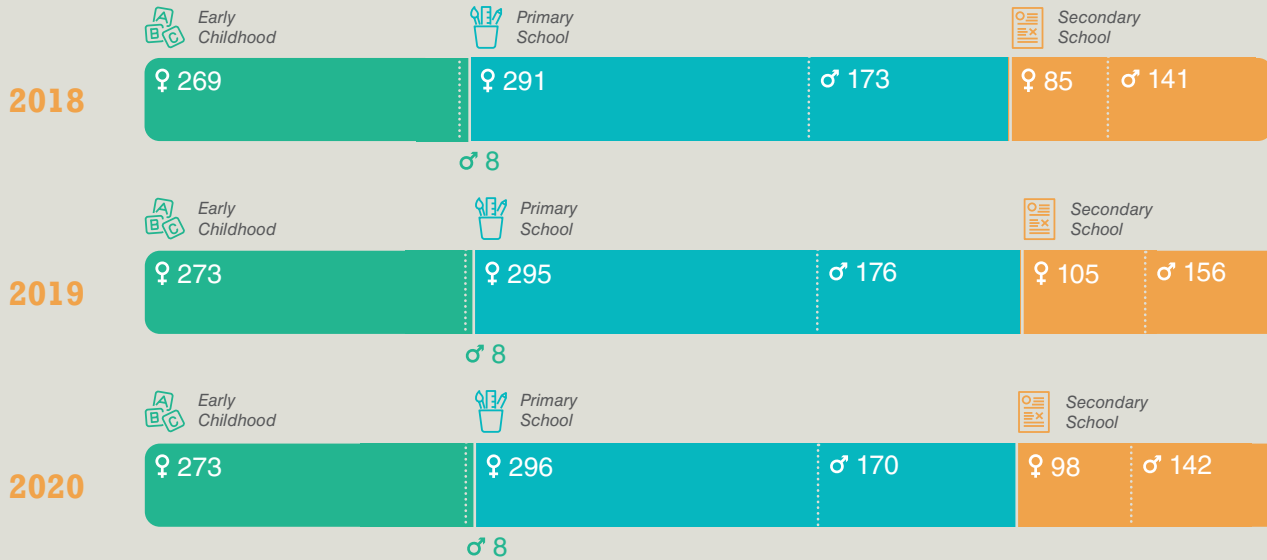

♀ Female ♂ Male



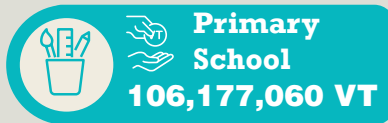
Grant allocations in 2020
