

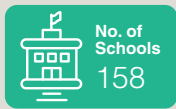


2020 Shefa Education Key Indicators

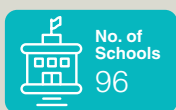

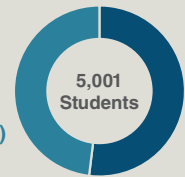

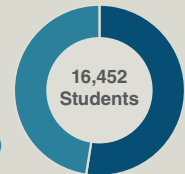

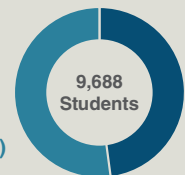

Actual student teacher ratio per school type

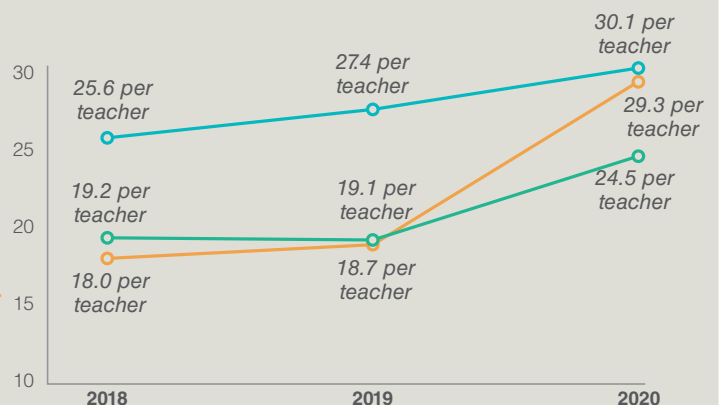
