Situation Overview

Data collection using Kobbo and forms update on-going and other alternatives have been considered to better support Data collection in Sanma province. So far with a total of 180 schools which is an increase of 82 schools (an increase of data entry for each province Torba 13 , Penama 17, Shefa 91, Tafea 17 and Malampa 30 and Tafea 18).

Education Cluster Updates

- On-going assessments on schools' damages and status of re-opening to better support the resource allocation of tents to schools that have major damages and tarpaulins to schools with minor damages.
- Distributions of stock will also be inline with enrollment capacity for efficiency.

Provincial Updates

SHEFA

- School Damages Out of 91 schools assessed in Shefa province, 75 schools have reported to have been damaged (55 reported with minor damage and 42 reported with major damage).
- Evacuation Centers Total of 40 schools used as evacuation centers (3 ECCE Centers ,28 Primary schools & 9 Secondary School).
- # of Evacuees 1154 +

MALAMPA

- School Damages Out of 30 schools assessed non have reported to be damaged.
- Evacuation Centers Total of 7 schools used as evacuation centers (0 ECCE ,5 Primary & 2 Secondary schools)
- # of Evacuees Yet TBC

PENAMA

- School Damages Out of 18 schools assessed 1 school has reported on Kobbo to have had minor and major damages.
- Evacuation Centers Total of 1 school used as evacuation center (1 ECCE center used).
- # of Evacuees Yet TBC

TORBA

- School Damages Assessments done on 18 school but non have reported with damages so far today.
- Evacuation Centers Total of 8 schools used as evacuation centers (5 Primary & 3 Secondary schools).
- # of Evacuees Yet TBC

TAFEA

- School Damages Assessments done on 18 schools and 9 have reported with minor damages and 10 reported with major damages so far today.
- Evacuation Centers 11 schools used as evacuation centers (10 primary & 1 secondary school)
- # of Evacuees Yet TBC

SANMA

- School Damages- 3 have reported with major damages so far today.
- Evacuation Centers No data available as yet for schools used as evacuation centers.
- # of Evacuees Yet TBC

Information captured during the assessments shows schools that have had minor or major damage or both partial minor and major damages on the school sites.

General Coordination

MoET Cluster coordination

Efforts have been made to enquire as to the number of schools that were able to open and
the number of school that need support open that is with tent /tarpaulin for building damages
,school bags to motivate children to schools and school in a box for those school curriculum
resources damaged.

MoET Van-Gov Students

- Flights for students in country yet to travel abroad for studies have been arranged and confirmed for student departure anytime from today.
- Allowances for continuing students (in country and overseas have been sorted for February and March.
- First year students allowance for overseas students have been made and submitted for payment into student accounts by next week (20-24/03/23).

EOC Coordination -

- MoET costed Response plan to NDMO has been approved.
- Data for 3W & 5W is currently in process to be updated by MoET planning team for consistency of information.
- Support is necessary to schools that have been able to resume on the 13th of March and those who are still having challenges to do so.
- Managers for each table to update daily progress to EOC controller so that information is channeled timely and for better co-ordination.
